LAMIMA

SPICE ISLANDS, BIRD OF PARADISE & THE HEAVENLY RAJA AMPAT

DESCRIBED BY SOME AS THE WORLD'S MOST BEAUTIFUL ISLANDS, RAJA AMPAT OFFERS STEEP JUNGLE CLAD LANDSCAPES, WHITE SAND BEACHES AND HIDDEN LAGOONS NOT TO MENTION SOME OF THE MOST BIODIVERSE MARINE LIFE ON THE PLANET.

Birds of Paradise still live here in the wild and are part of the local culture. Bird watching can be done in the forest or from your paddleboard in some sheltered bay.

Visiting the Banda Islands is a walk through history. On arrival in Banda Neira, the welcome from the "Kora Kora" will make you soon realize that you arrive in a special place where the locals are proud of their culture and want to share it with you. These tiny islands were the heart of the spice trade for many years and you can witness many colonial traditions.



SORONG TO AMBON IN 14 NIGHTS

DAY 1: THE PASSAGE

Early morning arrival in Sorong Airport where the crew will pick you up and bring you to Lamima. Once onboard, after a safety briefing, we will set sail for Waisai (Waigeo Island) where we will do the clearance. After the clearance is done, we will explore 'The Passage', a narrow straight that runs between Gam and Waigeo, where the rainforest meets the reef in a labyrinth of limestone teeming with wildlife. Here you can also enjoy bird watching or perhaps partake in some paddleboarding or kayaking.

DAY 2: KRI ISLAND

Take an early walk to witness the bird of paradise. They usually dance every day at sunrise before leaving their home tree for food. On our way back, we will visit a local village "Tapokreng" where we share a moment with the locals, greet the students of the elementary school and may try some betel nuts. Back on Lamima, we will cruise to Kri Island that has long sandbanks, good diving, and amazing kayaking through the hidden mangrove.

DAY 3: KAWA ISLAND

One of the closest islands to the Equator in Raja Ampat, Kawa Island offers spectacular white sand beaches and beautiful scenery including a lovely waterfall on the western side of the island. There are fantastic opportunities for diving and snorkeling here too where you will find impressive coral formations teeming with schools of fish. You may even be lucky enough to swim with manta rays.

DAY 4-5: WAYAG ISLANDS

Arrive in the Wayag archipelago, the jewel of Raja Ampat, and enjoy a day amongst the region's most iconic scenery. It is well worth making the effort to climb one of the many island peaks for breathtaking views of the stunning landscapes. You will also be able to dive or

snorkel, experiencing the incredibly rich marine life, or paddleboard along the shoreline of the dramatic limestone islands.

DAY 6: FAM ISLANDS

This morning, sail to the beautiful Fam Islands to enjoy hidden bays and sheltered blue lagoons. Explore by kayak or dive to see some of the most beautiful coral gardens in the region. In the early evening, we will take a sunset hike where you can reach the highest point on one of the islands and admire the panoramic views.

DAY 7: TOMOLOL

Today we anchor in Tomolol Bay on Misool Island. This bay is home to hundreds of small karts islands with each one more appealing than the others. This is a paradise to explore with one of our tenders and you can get lost in this maze all for yourself, the sea is crystal clear, very sheltered and the scenery exceptional. We will visit a massive cave where you can either go with a canoe, paddleboard or swim through. Stalactites are enormous, light is minimum and peace is everywhere. This cave today is a sacred site for the local people.

DAY 8: FARONDI

This small group of islands is often the favorite place for divers due to its very specific seascape. You will see a great variety of marine life and amazingly diverse and colorful coral. There are also perfectly rugged bays to explore on kayak or paddleboard.

DAY 9: WAYIL BATAN

Another magical place that you want to explore with a paddleboard to enter in the shallow bays of the island. You will find a lot of birdlife as well as close to the reef. Wake-boarding between the little mushroom islands is highly recommended.

DAY 10: KOON ISLAND

This is your ideal tropical island with beautiful white sandy beaches surrounded by a healthy reef. This area is famous for whales and dolphins if you are lucky you might be able to swim with them. This is the only island where fishing is prohibited. Swimming here is like being in an aquarium.

DAY 11: BANDA NEIRA, SPICE ISLANDS

Here you will be welcomed by the Kora Kora, who will escort you on your final approach to the main of the Spice Island: Banda Neira. Visit the old town which used to be the heart of the spice trade in the eighteen century, the possibility to enjoy the sunrise on the top of the volcano which will give you a panorama on the whole archipelago.

DAY 12-13: RUN ISLAND

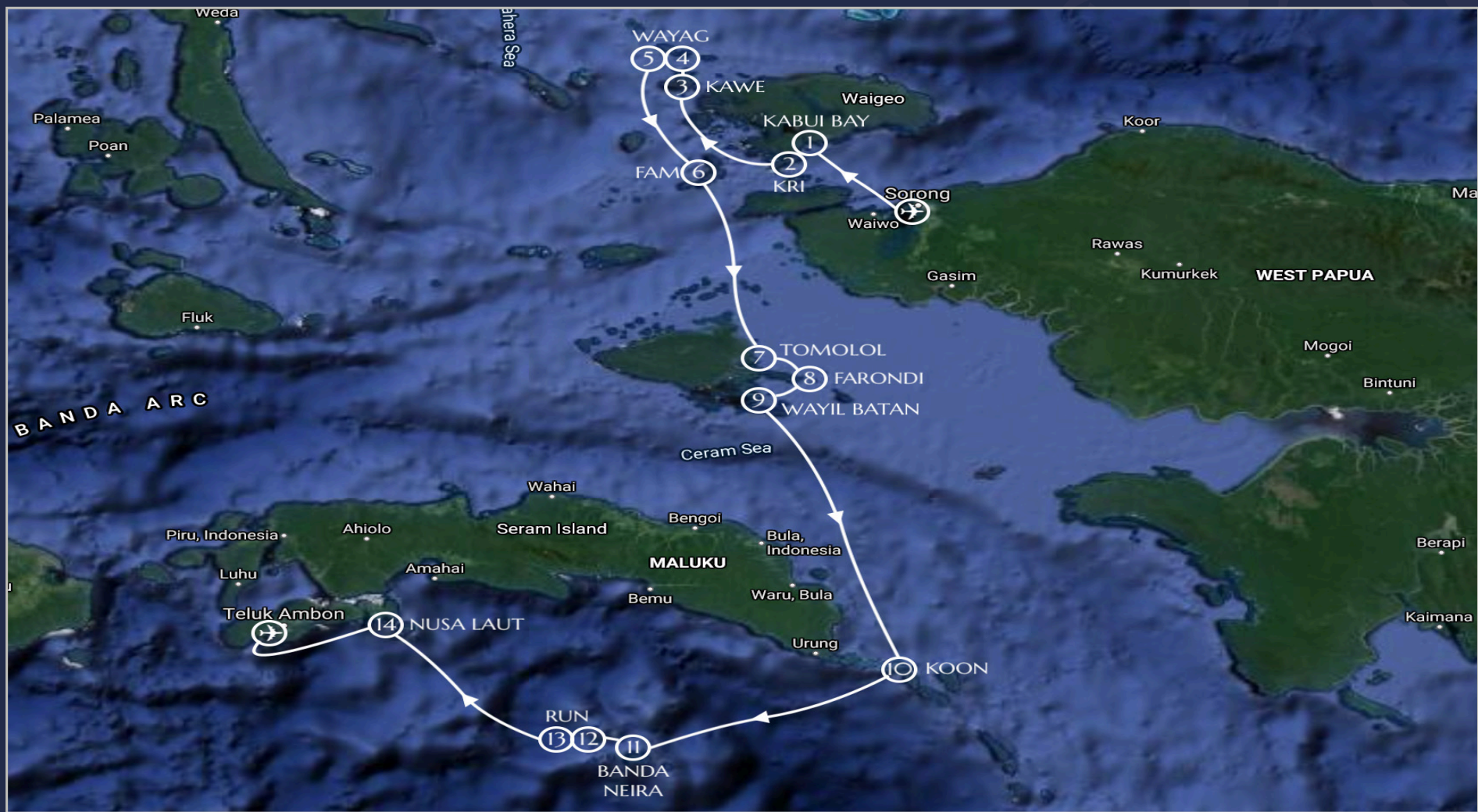
Run is all about diving. Divers will enjoy incredible visibility and will have a unique opportunity to witness schools of hammerhead sharks (October and November only), wall dives, and big fishes.

DAY 14: NUSA LAUT

We will have to ask permission from the locals to visit their village where we will be able to buy traditional "Ikat". Snorkeling or diving here is again very rewarding and you will see a huge variety of fishes. During lunch, we will move to Molana where our crew will prepare the beach for a memorable barbecue. During this course, the guests can enjoy any of the water sports and try trawling with the tender.

DAY 15: AMBON

Early morning move to Ambon bay and anchor next to the airport where guests will disembark after breakfast.
