The Realm of Dragons and Rich Marine Life

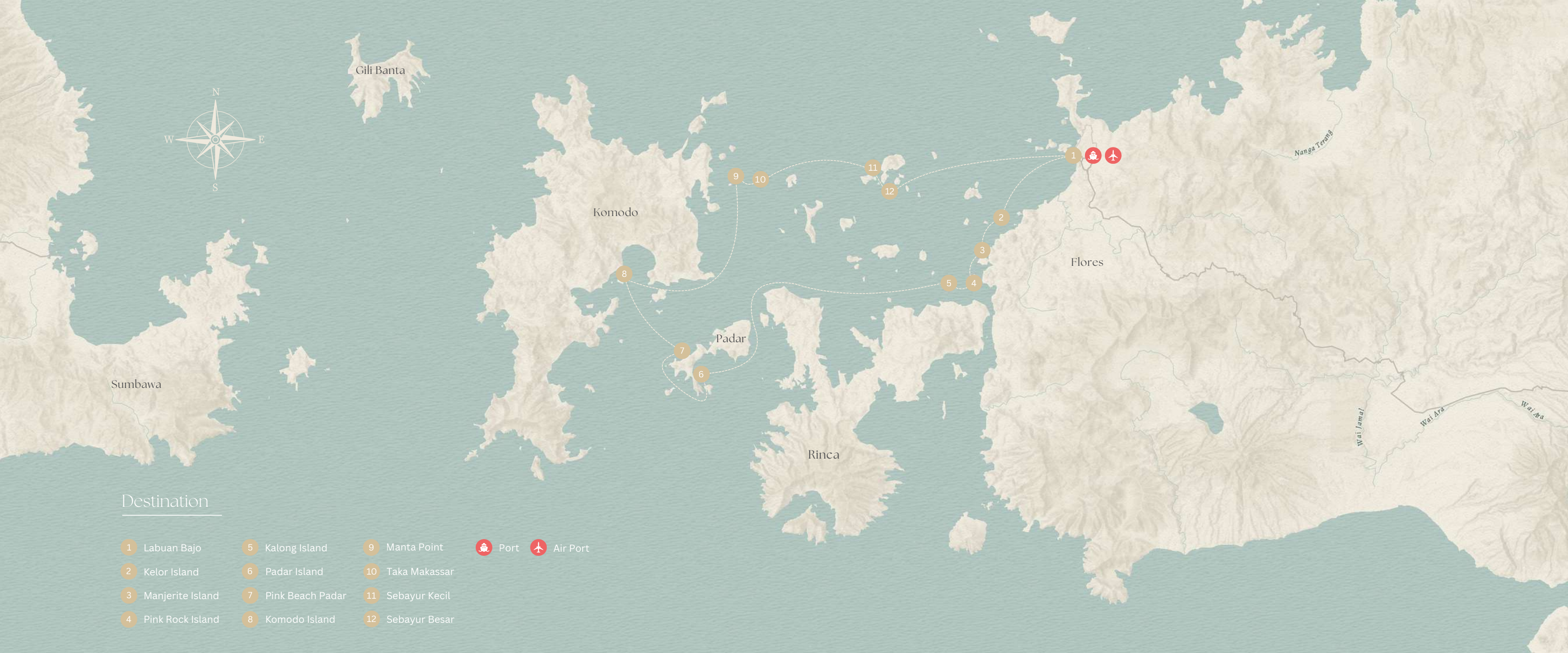
Komodo National Park, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site, covers an expansive area of 1,733 square kilometers within Indonesia's Lesser Sunda Islands. Renowned for being the natural habitat of the Komodo the world's largest lizard-the park is a treasure trove of diverse wildlife and striking landscapes, ranging from arid savannas to lush tropical forests.

The park also boasts a rich marine ecosystem featuring over 1,000 species of fish and 260 types of coral.

It is a prime location for encountering manta rays and sea turtles, making it a premier destination for diving and snorkeling enthusiasts. Visitors can explore the park's three principal islands-Komodo, Rinca, and Padar-each offering spectacular vistas, secluded beaches, and unparalleled opportunities to observe unique wildlife.

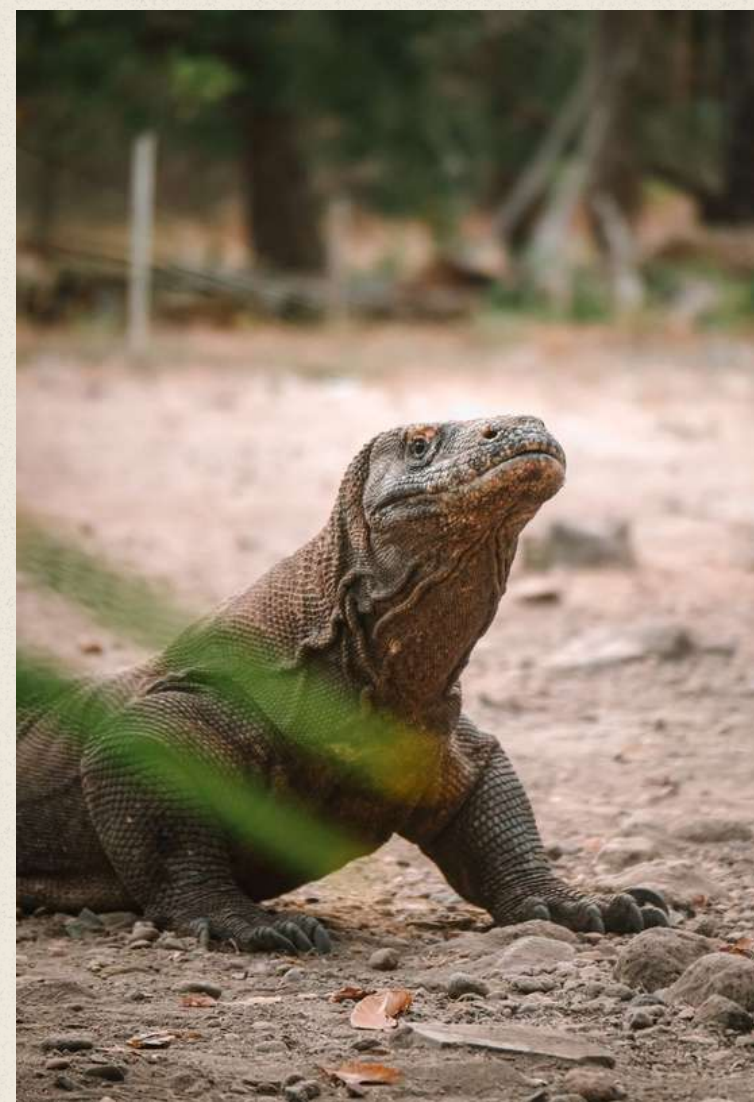
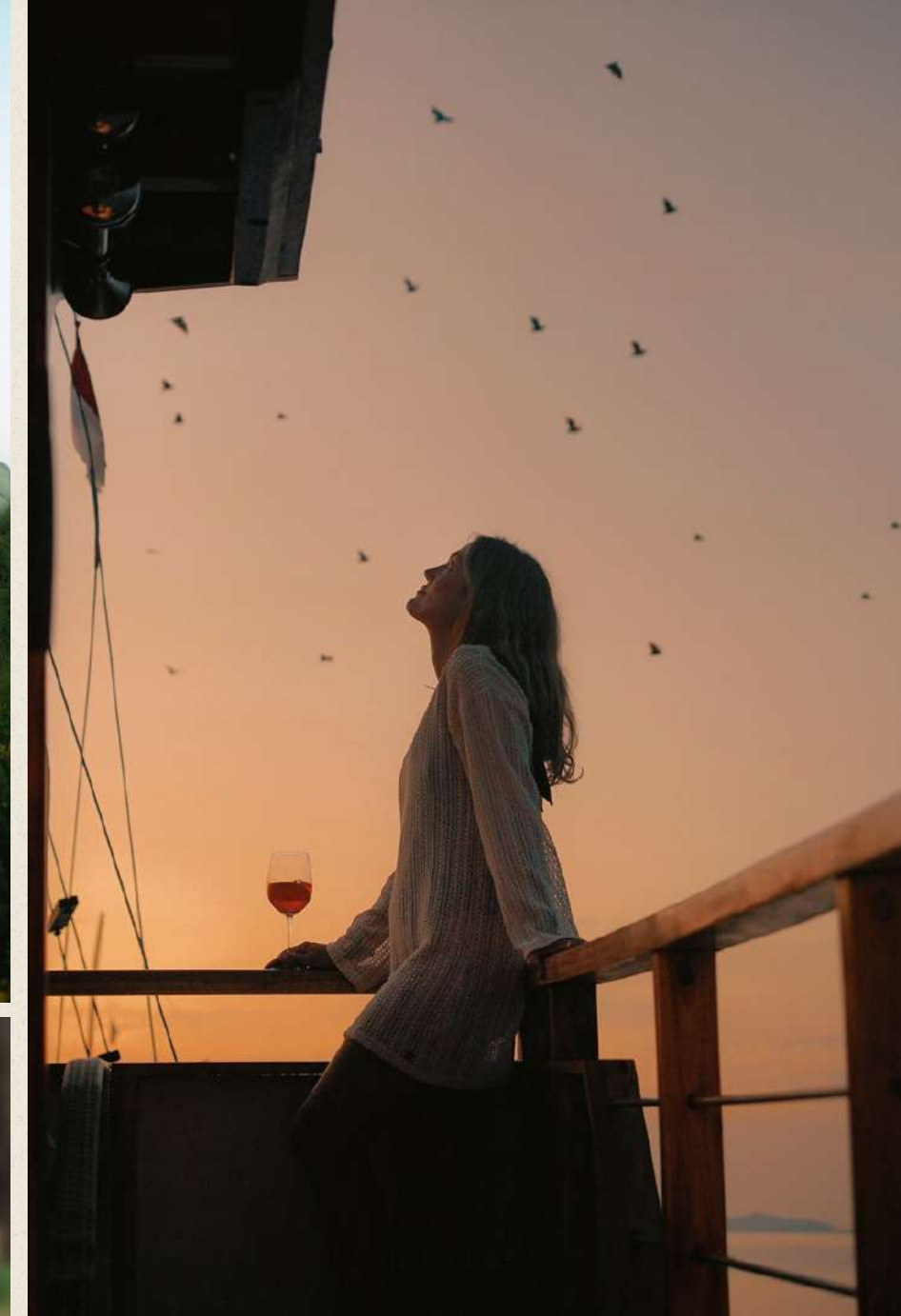


KOMODO NATIONAL PARK | 3 DAYS 2 NIGHT

Day 01

Kelor | Manjerite | Pink Rock | Kalong

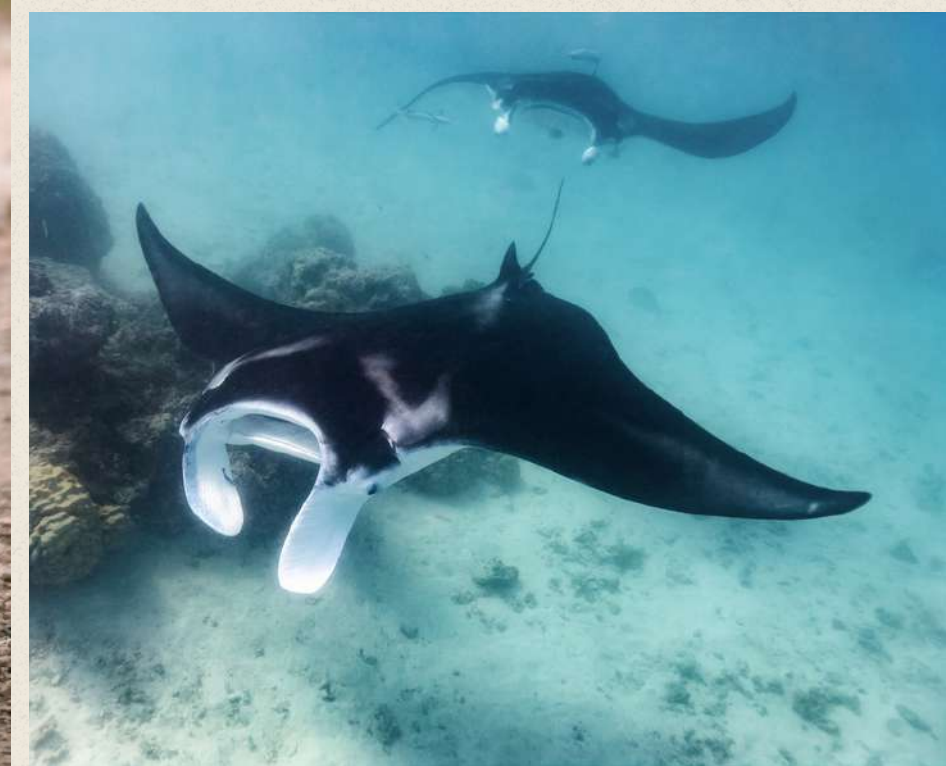
Your journey begins at Kelor Island with a short hike or a relaxing swim, followed by a delicious lunch onboard. Afterward, head to Manjerite for marine exploration, then proceed to Pink Rock for snorkeling and paddleboarding amidst vibrant coral reefs. As the day winds down, catch the breathtaking sunset at Kalong Island, where thousands of flying foxes take to the sky. End the day with dinner onboard while cruising towards Padar Island for an overnight anchorage.



Day 02

Padar | Pink Beach | Komodo | Taka Makassar | Manta Point

Start the day early with a sunrise hike at Padar Island, taking in its iconic views. Return to the boat for breakfast before heading to Pink Beach for some relaxation or snorkeling in the crystal-clear waters. Next, visit Komodo Island for a guided trek to see the legendary Komodo dragons. After lunch onboard, continue to Taka Makassar and Manta Point for a chance to snorkel with graceful manta rays. The day concludes with a crossing to Sebayur Besar for an overnight stay.





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Day 03

Sebayur Kecil | Sebayur Besar

Following breakfast, enjoy snorkeling at Sebayur Kecil or the more secluded Sebayur Besar, both known for their vibrant marine life. After your final swim, the journey back to Labuan Bajo begins, marking the end of your unforgettable Komodo experience.
