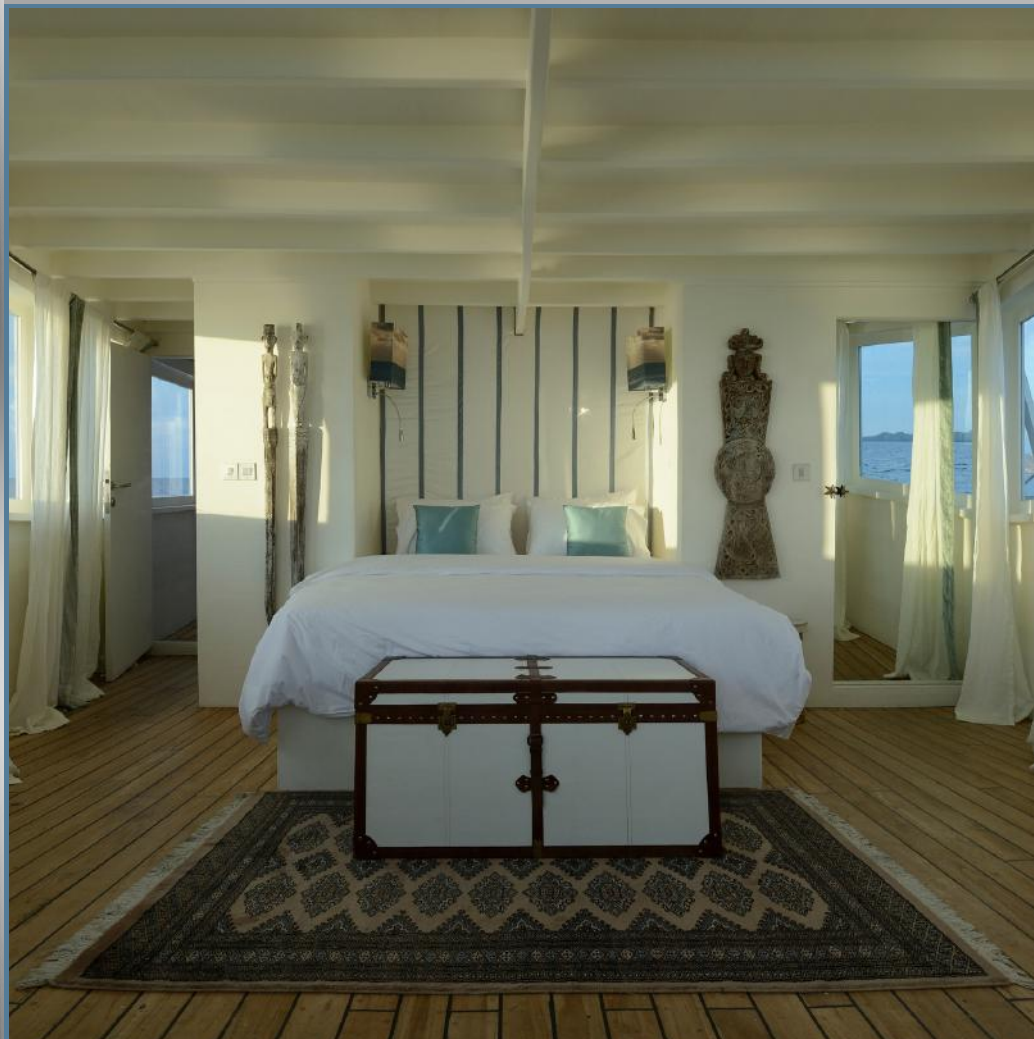

NORTHERN FLORES & ALOR

This 10-nights journey through the northern coast of Flores and the Alor region offers an immersive exploration of Indonesia's untouched natural beauty and vibrant cultures.

Starting from Labuan Bajo, travellers will dive into the crystal-clear waters of Flores, exploring pristine beaches and iconic Rangko Cave. The route then leads to Teluk Riang, Pulau Raja, and Maumere, where you'll discover hidden beaches, coral reefs, and traditional villages. The journey continues with stops at the Ipet Islands, Serbete Reef, and North Lembata, where incredible underwater experiences await alongside cultural encounters with indigenous peoples.

Visiting the remote Sika Island allows time to relax on secluded beaches and immerse in the traditional lifestyle of the Abui Tribe, offering a rare chance to experience one of the last unspoiled corners of Indonesia. This itinerary beautifully blends world-class diving with authentic cultural encounters, offering a perfect balance of adventure, relaxation, and discovery.

DAY 1 WELCOME TO FLORES

ALEXA's representative will greet you upon arrival at the airport, assist you with your luggage and escort you to your floating penthouse awaiting at Labuan Bajo Harbour which is a ten minute drive. While your luggage is transferred aboard ALEXA, enjoy a refreshing welcome drink and a tour of the facilities aboard. You will meet the team, share any last minute requests and receive a safety briefing for your stay with us.

Enjoy the incredible views of the crossing to Rangko Cave, whilst snacks and drinks are served onboard.

Lunch will be served once we arrive.

Go for a swim with the turtles and relax on the beach after which we will bring you to Rangko Cave and have your personal Spa Therapist arrange the spa treatments for a relaxed afternoon after your visit to the cave.

Sunset drinks will be served before dinner onboard whilst ALEXA drops the anchor for the night.





DAY 2 TELUK RIANG

Teluk Riang is a beautiful stop for travellers looking to explore the less-traveled, serene spots along Flores' northern coastline while enjoying vibrant marine life and a glimpse into the traditional lifestyles of local communities.

Due to the area's remote and underdeveloped tourism, the marine environment is quite pristine.

Teluk Riang, also known as Riang Bay, is a scenic coastal area located on the north coast of Flores Island, near Maumere. It's a relatively lesser-known destination, but it's popular among divers and snorkelers because of its healthy coral reefs, calm waters, and marine biodiversity.



DAY 3 PULAU RAJA

In the morning we arrive at the beautiful coastline of Pulau Raja which is home a local village, a couple dive spots and an active volcano.

Pulau Raja's waters offer a chance to spot a variety of marine life, we take an opportunity to go for a snorkel before visiting a local village where they, use hot springs to do their wash their handwoven textiles, an alternative not available for most.

As the evening approaches you will have time for a relaxing massage onboard whilst your chef prepares a delicious three-course dinner.

After your meal and once you relax, ALEXA will begin the voyage towards Maumere and Pulau Besar.



DAY 4

MAUMERE & PULAU BESAR

Maumere is the main town along the North Flores coastline and gives the impression of a sleepy village.

There are a few Japanese wrecks in Maumere Bay, remnants from WWII, which have since become artificial reefs teeming with marine life. These are great for both novice and advanced divers interested in underwater history.

For those who prefer snorkeling or relaxing, Maumere Bay has several shallow, accessible sites with vibrant reefs. Beaches around the bay, including the area near Wairtek and other small coves.





DAY 5

THE IPET ISLANDS & SERBETE REEF

Serbete Reef, located northeast of Maumere Bay, is one of the most renowned reef systems in the region, celebrated for its impressive coral diversity, excellent visibility, and abundance of marine life. Known for its beauty and biodiversity. The islands' location in the Flores Sea attracts larger marine life, including reef sharks, rays, and sometimes barracudas.

During certain times of the year, Serbete Reef is visited by manta rays, making it a thrilling spot for divers hoping for encounters with these graceful creatures.

DAY 6

NORTH LEMBATA & LEWO HALA VILLAGE

Lembata has a long history of traditional whale hunting.

While modern-day whale hunting is less common, the culture remains part of the island's heritage. Travelers can learn about the historical significance of whale hunting in Lewo Hala and observe the methods and rituals associated with it.

Mount Ili Lewotolok is an active stratovolcano on the island offers stunning views and treks for adventurous travelers. Hikers can explore its crater and the surrounding rugged landscapes, offering panoramic views of the island and the sea.

Lewo Hala is a traditional village located on the northeastern coast of Lembata, which offers visitors a unique cultural experience, blending both natural beauty and the opportunity to learn about the island's indigenous way of life. The village is particularly known for its traditional architecture, local ceremonies, and close-knit community.





DAY 7 SOUTH-WEST PANTAR

The island of Pantar is a volcanic island, and trekking to the higher parts offers panoramic views of the surrounding islands, including Alor, Lembata, and the Pantar Strait.

South-West Pantar is home to traditional villages that offer insights into the local culture. These villages maintain a way of life that has remained largely unchanged for centuries, with traditional houses and customs.

Depending on the time of year, visitors may be able to participate in or observe traditional ceremonies, dances, and rituals that celebrate the natural environment and their ancestral beliefs.



DAY 8

THE ALOR STRAIT

The Alor Strait, located between Alor Island and Pantar Island, is one of the most biodiverse marine environments in the world. Known for its deep waters, vibrant coral reefs, and rich marine life, it is a prime destination for diving and snorkeling. The strait serves as a natural boundary between the two islands and is part of the Coral Triangle, an area famous for its underwater biodiversity. This makes for a unique opportunity to spot Blue Whales.

Whether you're diving with manta rays, hiking volcanic mountains, or learning about local traditions, the Alor Strait provides an unforgettable experience.





DAY 9 & 10 SIKA ISLAND & THE ABUI TRIBE

Sika Island is a great spot for birdwatching, with a variety of species calling the island home, including migratory birds during certain seasons. The island's remote nature provides an excellent opportunity to see wildlife in its natural habitat.



The Abui Tribe is one of the indigenous groups of Alor Island and is known for its rich cultural traditions, unique language, and vibrant social structures. The Abui people live mainly in the mountainous areas of northern and central Alor, but they also inhabit coastal regions like Sika Island.

Many of the villages welcome visitors and offer guided tours.

These tours provide insights into local daily life, such as farming, fishing, and community rituals. If you're lucky, you may be invited to participate in a local ceremony or feast.

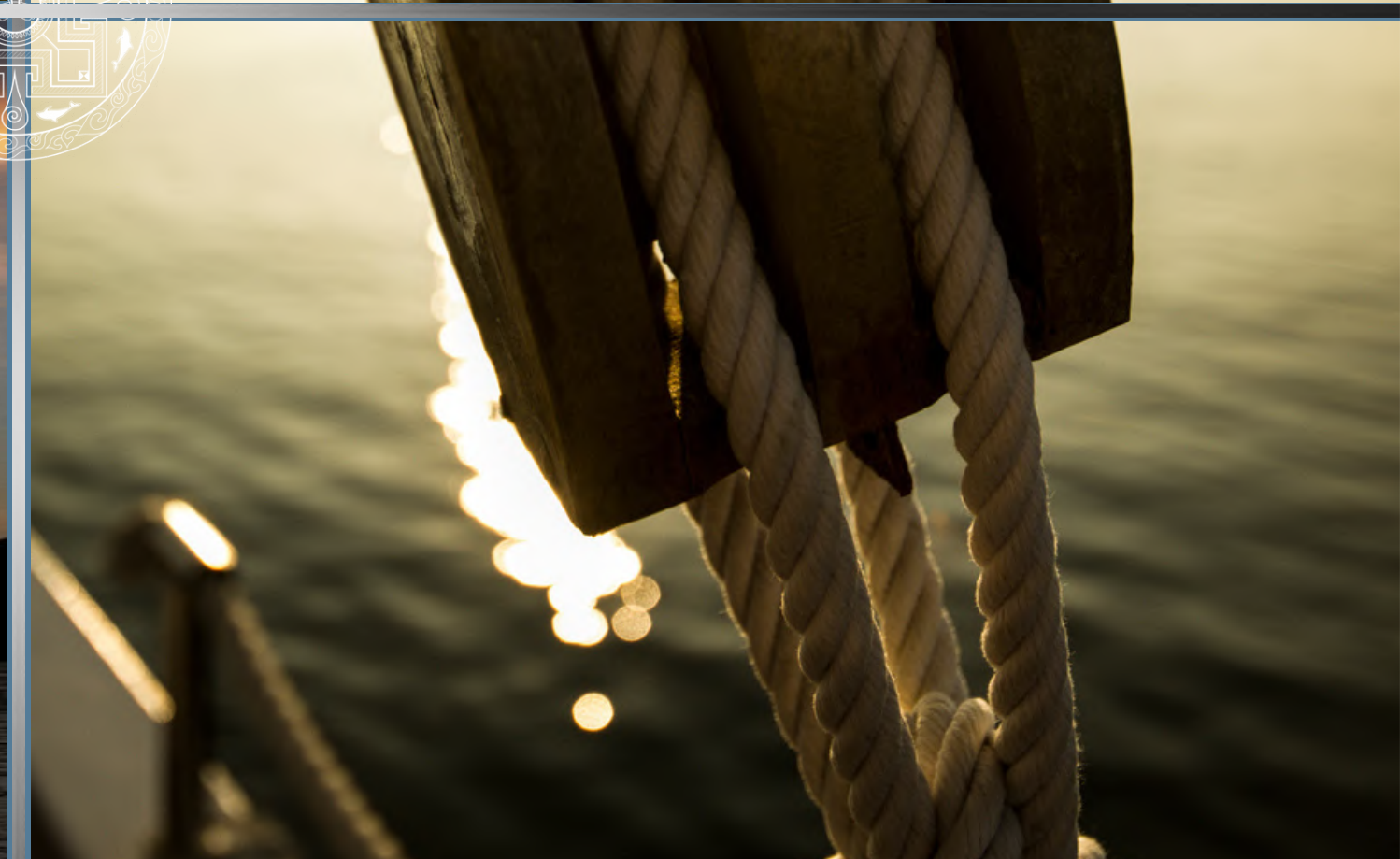
