KOMODO NATIONAL PARK

JUST A SHORT FLIGHT FROM THE BEACHES OF BALI, KOMODO NATIONAL PARK IS A PLACE OF TRULY DIVERSE NATURAL BEAUTY AND INCREDIBLE WILDLIFE. OFFERING SIGNATURE PINK-SAND BEACHES AND SOME OF THE WORLD'S BEST DIVING, IT'S A DESTINATION THAT WON'T DISAPPOINT.

Teeming with sea life, Komodo National Park's plentiful coral reefs are considered to be some of the best in all of Indonesia. Dolphins and Manta Rays are a common sight and the area is also on a whale migration route.

The grassy sloped islands that make up the park offer visitors gentle trekking trails and beautiful beaches to relax on, as well as the opportunity to see the famous Komodo Dragons, the largest living lizards on the planet.



A SAMPLE 10 NIGHTS ITINERARY

DAY 1: LABUAN BAJO & GILI LAWА DARAT

On arrival at the airport, our crew will transfer you to Lamima. While the guests are relaxing and having lunch, we will set sail for Gili Lawa Darat. There, we will anchor in a secluded bay with stunning scenery close to some of the most exciting dives in Indonesia.

Here you will dive or snorkel with schools of fish including trevally, groupers, sweetlips, barracudas, and white tip reef sharks. These waters are teeming with incredible marine life. In the afternoon, we will take a hike to a spectacular viewpoint from where we can see Lamima anchored in the bay.

HIGHLIGHTS:

A sheltered bay, beautiful scenery, nice sunset viewpoint, white sand beach.

Activities: Paddleboard, wakeboard, snorkeling, diving, hiking

Diving: Schooling fish like giant trevally, black snapper, bigeye trevally, white tip reef sharks, turtle and sometimes manta ray.

DAY 2: MT. SANGEANG ISLAND

An active volcano called Sangeang is a natural phenomenon with amazing topography. Reefs are excellent here with good visibility and volcanic black sand background allowing you to appreciate the colorful soft and hard corals as well as different types of anemones. Dive on Hot Rock Reef on the active volcano to be surrounded by harmless but amazing sulfur bubbles from a natural underwater vent. Overnight cruise to Teluk Saleh.

HIGHLIGHTS:

Active Volcano, small community making big traditional boat, village, buffalo, black sand.

Activities: Jetski is allowed here and any other water sports, snorkeling, diving, visit the village.

Diving: Bright colorful reef with black sand as background, many nudibranchs, bubbles coming out from the sand, the hot rock underwater, pygmy seahorse. DAY 3: TELUK SALEH and MOYO ISLAND

Teluk Saleh has attracted a lot of interest recently as some whale sharks have been spotted in the bay and remain there since. We will try our luck and we might have the opportunity to swim with them. Later in the afternoon we will explore and swim in the rock pool of Moyo.

DAY 4: SATONDA

Satonda Island was formed with the eruption of Mt. Tambora, the second largest volcano eruption ever recorded. This small island has a crater in the middle that is a saltwater lake. The surrounding beaches in Satonda are perfect for spending the afternoon snorkeling and paddleboarding. This is also an ideal area for amazing snorkeling and a check dive where it's possible to see pygmy seahorses and a wide variety of marine life. Overnight cruise to Gili Banta.

DAY 5: GILI BANTA

Today's calling point is the perfect spot for a relaxed day of walks on the long, white sand beach or perhaps some watersports in a sheltered bay surrounded by beautiful scenery as jet skiing is allowed in this area. With its hard coral gardens, it's a great place for shallow and drift diving with the possibility of swimming with Manta Rays.

HIGHLIGHTS:

Nice long white beach, sheltered bay, beautiful scenery, a good place for BBQ.

Activities: Set up the beach, jetski are allowed here and any other water sports, snorkeling, diving, BBQ

Diving: Nice hard coral gardens, shallow dive, a possible encounter with Manta Ray, slow drift dive.

DAY 6: GILI LAWА LAUT

In the morning, we sail to the northernmost part of Komodo National Park. Here, you will swim with schools of fish of varying species including trevally, groupers, sweetlips, barracudas and white tip reef sharks. In the afternoon, we will take a hike to a spectacular viewpoint from where we can see Lamima anchored in the bay below.

HIGHLIGHTS:

North of Komodo National Park, nice long, white sand beach, viewpoint.

Activities: Diving, snorkeling, hiking, paddleboard, kayak

Diving: Current dive, shy place, schooling fusilier, giant trevally, bigeye

trevally, barracuda, grouper, sweetlips, white tip reef shark

A SAMPLE 10 NIGHTS ITINERARY

DAY 7: SOUTH RINCA

In the morning, sail to South Rinca, one of the region's best dive sites. Here, you will get to experience the best of what Komodo National Park has to offer. Swim with nudibranch, turtles, sea snakes and frogfish among some of the most colorful corals in Indonesia. After lunch, we will take you by tender to the shore where you will be able to see the world's largest living lizard, the Komodo Dragon.

HIGHLIGHTS:

A nice sheltered bay, beaches with Komodo Dragon. Popular dive site.

Activities: Diving, snorkeling, visit the beach to see the wild Komodo dragon.

Diving: One of the best dive on the trip, colorful soft coral, many nudibranchs, turtle, sea snake, frogfish, water temperature 23 Celcius.

DAY 8: KARANG MAKASSAR & PADAR ISLAND

This morning we will monitor the tide to go at the right time to Makassar straight where we will swim and drift with the Manta. This is a place where you can see "mantas train," it is quite common to see around ten Mantas following each other swimming in the current in search of food. During lunch, we will cruise to the Island of Padar. Get your camera ready for the most epic Komodo picture of three bays from the top of Padar island. Divers can check out nearby Three Sisters. In the afternoon, walk across the narrowest part of the island to Pink Beach, where tiny pink organisms called Foraminifera give the beach its distinct color.

HIGHLIGHTS:

Karang Makassar is a popular place to do snorkeling with Manta Ray. While the guests are having lunch, the boat will move to Padar Island. Padar is beautiful scenery with a nice long beach, pink beach, sunset viewpoint.

Activities: Snorkeling, hiking, visit Pink beach Snorkeling: Drift snorkeling with Manta Ray

DAY 9: TATAWA BESAR

This is the place to see many turtles during diving.

For sunset, we can watch thousands of bats at pecky island.

HIGHLIGHTS:

Nice white sand beach, and beautiful scenery around.

Activities: Diving, snorkeling, visit the beach

Diving: One of the healthiest corals in the Komodo and the best spot to see turtles

Drift dive, clear water, lot of fish schooling.

DAY 10: BIDA DARI

After the activity on Padar, we will put the sails up going to Bida Dari where we will drop anchor and enjoy watersport for the rest of the day followed by sunset barbeque on the beach.

HIGHLIGHTS:

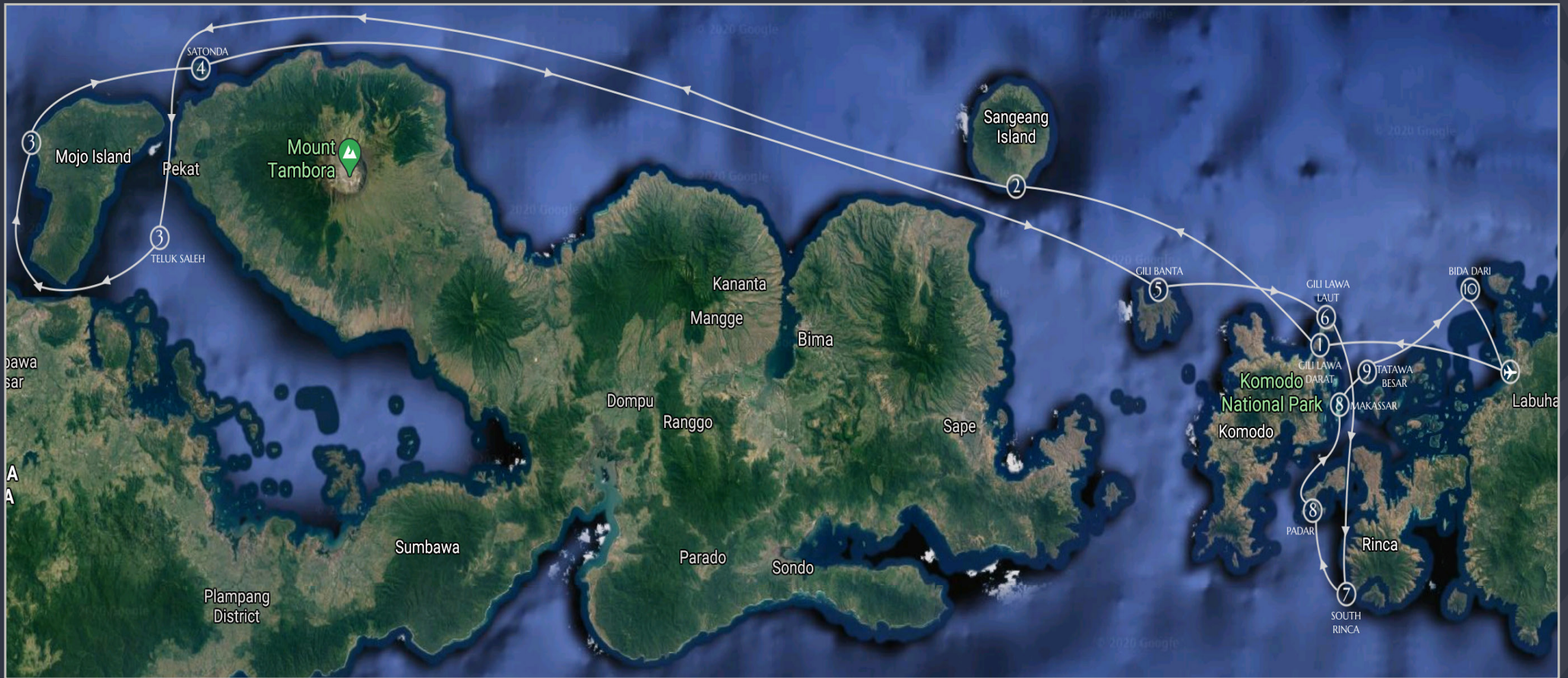
Nice white beach.

Activities: Jet ski is allowed here and any other water sports, diving, snorkeling

Diving: Beautiful reef dive, barracuda, cuttlefish, octopus, leaf scorpionfish, pygmy sea horse

DAY 10: LABUAN BAJO

Last day to Bidadari Island where you will be able to enjoy your last swim and watersport before we transfer you back to the port by tender from where a private vehicle will take you to Labuan Bajo Airport for your onward journey.
