“ALEXA Private Cruises” (Registered in Indonesia as: PT. Permata Libra Mandiri)
Updated and enforced from 1st January 2025

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOUR PRIVATE CRUISE

A 50% deposit is required within 7 days of booking to secure your reservation. Balance of total fare is required strictly 90 days prior to departure.

Completion of our terms and conditions and guest registration form is required within 7 days of your confirmed reservation to secure your requested dates.

DURING A CRUISE ONBOARD ALEXA THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:

Inclusions:

Exclusive use of ALEXA with just One Luxury Suite with 270 degree panoramic windows including all gourmet meals, refreshments and snacks, house wines and alcoholic beverages**, up to 3 dives per day for certified scuba divers, use of SUP & kayak, daily massages, national park entrance fees, shore excursions, island expeditions, snorkelling, sustainable line fishing (when permitted) & government tax.

Exclusions:

Rates quoted exclude international and domestic airfare, premium/pre-ordered wines, champagnes and spirits, excess baggage fees, relocation fees, passport, visas or airport tax fees (both international and domestic), scuba diving certification costs, travel/medical insurance, Bank Transfer Fee's, relocations, crew gratuities***.

Main Feature:

The 31-metre-long ALEXA consists of two decks and has been built by hand in the traditional style of a Phinisi. In keeping with ALTER NAVIS' emphasis on style and sustainability, the furniture throughout the boat is custom-made from teak, rattan and other locally sourced materials from Indonesia.

Accommodation:

One well-appointed suite, with air-conditioning and queen size (170cm x 210cm) bed, en-suite bathroom with shower, double wardrobe, and balcony relaxation area. The master suite, which is expansively designed boasting large, wraparound windows offering 270-degree views of the ever-changing yet incredible landscape providing the ultimate space for relaxation.

Facilities:

Lounge, open kitchen, indoor dining area seating up to 4 people, Under the Stars sleeping area, and plenty of space outside to unwind and enjoy the views. Guests will be able to dine at leisure in the

air-conditioned dining room or on the outdoor deck. The main outdoor deck has large oversized daybeds shaded by tarpaulin - perfect for relaxing day or night and enjoying the fresh sea breezes. With a masseur aboard the vessel, guests can succumb to the soothing pleasures of a signature ALEXA massage on-board or on a nearby beach.

Activities:

The ALEXA also has her own fully licensed PADI dive centre, catering to qualified divers. There is plenty of equipment for all guests on-board as well as a dedicated freshwater rinse tank for camera equipment and a GoPro provided by our crew. Discover Scuba Diving sessions are available free of charge to those who are not certified, and would like to try diving without gaining a certification.

Open Water courses can only be completed on-board, if theory and confined/pool sessions have been finalised prior to arrival and comes at an additional cost of USD 500.

For those with a taste for adventure, line fishing (where permitted), snorkelling, hiking, SUP, visiting local islands and pearl farms are among the many other pursuits on offer.

** Complimentary alcohol includes: 2 bottles of wine, 1 bottle of spirit & 10 bottles of local beer per day. Please note the inclusive alcoholic beverages cannot be swapped out for their value against any premium pre-purchases.

*** Crew gratuities are offered at your complete discretion (guideline 8-15% of the cruise value). This can be paid either directly to the crew when on-board the ALEXA, or pre-paid prior to boarding.

Check in & check out:

Check in time is from 09.00am on the day of arrival, and check out time is set at 14.00pm on the final day.

We can arrange a tour of the local area, or a lunch at a restaurant should you wish to take a flight later than 14.00pm on the day of departure. Late check out can be arranged if necessary with prior notice.

We will provide transportation to ensure you promptly reach the airport.

Cellular and Internet:

While visiting most of the remote islands, the cellular signal is often very weak and sometimes unobtainable however we do have Starlink WIFI onboard ensuring that you always stay connected if needed.

If you require your own SIM card with 4G capabilities, please do so on arrival to Indonesia, your arrival hotel will be able to assist in this service.

Items you may wish to take on-board with you:

- Sun screen, after sun lotion, sunglasses and a hat
- Scuba Diving license & logbook (if you have one)
- Flip Flops and closed shoes or sneakers for island trekking
- A long sleeve shirt and perhaps a light jacket
- Medication (if necessary)
- Cigarettes & Cigars - please note, smoking is prohibited in all enclosed area of the yacht.
- A special bottle of alcohol (perhaps from home or the airport) - we do not charge corkage fees.

CANCELLATION POLICY AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please see table below regarding cancellation and refund policy. No refunds will be made in the event of "no shows", or cancellations received late or after the start of the cruise.

< 181 days	20% charge of full cruise value
180 - 151 days	30% charge of full cruise value
150 - 121 days	40% charge of full cruise value
120 - 59 days	50% charge of full cruise value
60 - 0 days	100% charge of full cruise value

PT. Permata Libra Mandiri is not responsible for any charges caused by the transfer process and if there is any alteration of exchange rate (USD to IDR). Change of your cruise dates are possible, and will be subject to an additional 10% fee of the total cruise value. Date changes are only possible 120 days prior to original cruise start date.

Late Payment Penalty

Invoices are due in full by the payment due date stated on the invoice. Any payment not received by this date will be considered late and subject to a penalty. A late fee of \$500 will be applied starting one week from the first day after the due date. This penalty will increase by an additional \$500 for each full week the payment remains overdue. Continued non-payment may result in the cancellation of the booking.

Travel Insurance

We strongly recommend you purchase appropriate international travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit. If you do not purchase travel insurance, you may not be able to recover cancellation charges, medical costs, repatriation and other expenses that may arise if things do not go according to plan.

Cancellation & Refunds

Although we would love to see you on-board, we understand that plans can change. Should you need to cancel your booking, we ask that you notify us at your earliest convenience. All cancellations must be received in writing to info@alexaprivatecruises.com (or via your agent). The refund or cancellation charges that will be payable depending on the amount of notice you give us, as per the above table. Any refunds outside of our terms will be a claim on your insurance company.

Responsibility

There is nothing more important to us than the safety of our guests and all activities are carried out under strict and safe supervision.
