DAY 01

ARRIVAL, SUMBAWA BESAR

You'll be picked up at the airport or your hotel and welcomed on board with refreshing drinks and light snacks. Your Cruise Director will introduce the crew, provide a safety briefing, and walk you through how life on board works as well as what to expect from the cruise ahead.

Once you're settled into your cabin, take some time to refresh and prepare for the first leg of your journey, sailing toward Pulau Moyo. A hidden gem of Sumbawa, Pulau Moyo is rich in natural beauty, with tropical forests, cascading waterfalls, and clear turquoise waters.

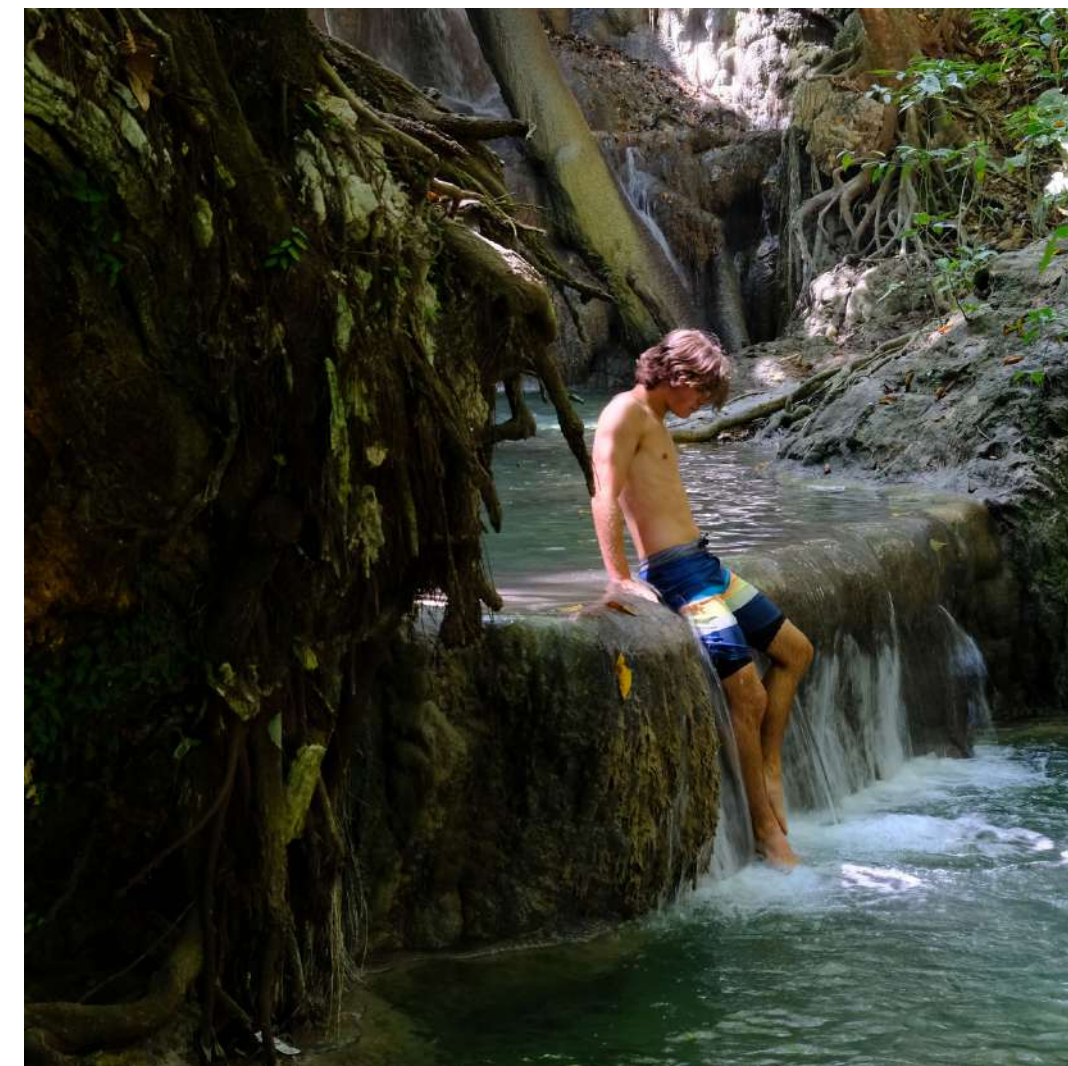
Spend your day snorkelling or diving along coral reefs bustling with marine life, or take a short trek inland to discover the island's jungle trails and waterfalls.

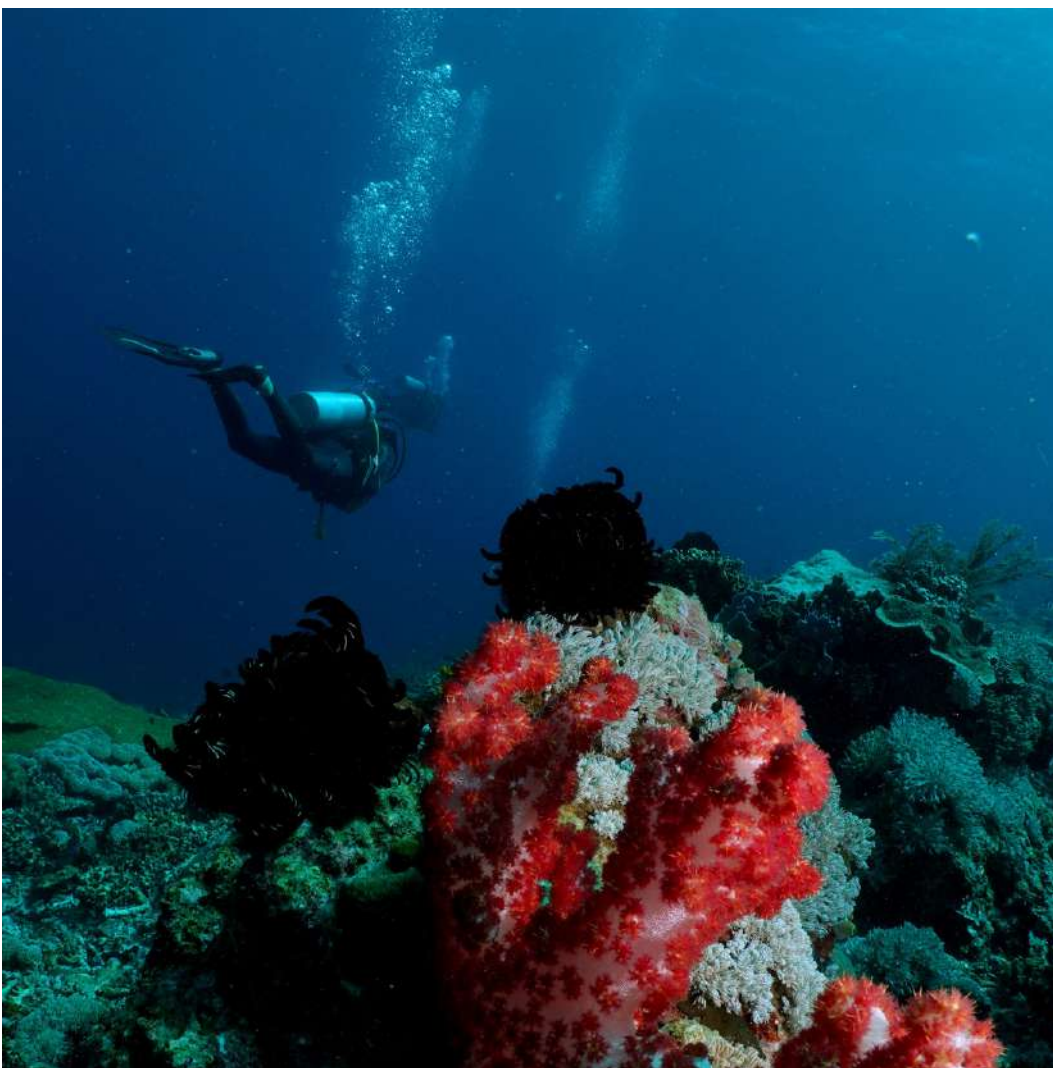
Whether you prefer underwater discovery or land-based adventure, Moyo offers something for everyone.

DAY

02

SALEH BAY – WHALE SHARKS

Begin your morning exploring Saleh Bay, a calm and biodiverse marine haven. This area offers exceptional opportunities to encounter whale sharks, especially around the local bagan—traditional fishing platforms where small anchovies are harvested. These platforms often attract whale sharks, drawn by the abundance of food. We dedicate time at these sites, snorkeling and diving in respectful proximity to observe these gentle giants up close—a truly humbling and unforgettable experience.

Enjoy snorkelling or diving in this peaceful bay, surrounded by rich marine life and tranquil scenery.

In the afternoon, Jakare will lift anchor and sail eastward, take this time to relax, reflect, or enjoy the company of your fellow travellers as the boat glides across the sea.

DAY

03

PULAU SANGEANG

Today you'll wake up near Pulau Sangeang, a stunning volcanic island with dramatic black sand beaches and surreal underwater topography.

Walk along the charcoal-colored shore and prepare for one of Komodo's most magical dive experiences at Bubble Reef, where volcanic gases rise from the seabed in a shimmering curtain of bubbles. Whether you're diving or snorkeling, this site is truly unique.

By mid-afternoon, Jakare will set sail eastward toward Sumbawa east coastline, overnight not far from Kalimaya Resort, a diving resort located in the eastern coast line of Sumbawa.

DAY 04

KALIMAYA - PANTAI MERAH & PULAU BANTA

Your morning begins with a gentle plunge into the turquoise waters of Kalimaya's house reef—an underwater world teeming with color and life. Whether you choose to dive or snorkel, this serene start sets the rhythm for a day of exploration.

From there, you'll sail westward to a quieter corner of Komodo's famed Pantai Merah—the iconic pink beach, minus the crowds. Wade into the shallows, snorkel above thriving reefs, or simply wander the blushing sands in peaceful solitude.

Later in the day, adventure picks up at Cape Area and Pulau Kambing, where diving and snorkeling can be arranged based on the tides. These sites are alive with strong currents, flourishing coral reefs, and an abundance of marine life. You'll also have time for stand-up paddleboarding, kayaking, or a slow barefoot stroll along the untouched coastline.

As the sun dips low, Jakare sets her course toward Pulau Banta, an uninhabited volcanic island, where you'll drop anchor for the night beneath a starlit sky.





DAY 05 - 06

PULAU BANTA AND NORTH KOMODO

Awaken to the ancient beauty of Pulau Banta, a dramatic volcanic island shaped by time. Explore its crescent bay, its narrow inlets, and golden beaches where you'll likely be the only soul around. With no Komodo dragons reported here, it's a safe and peaceful haven.

Enjoy a morning of trekking, kayaking, or simply basking in the pristine waters. Beneath the surface, vibrant coral gardens and walls beckon divers and snorkelers alike.

By afternoon, Jakare begins her eastward journey into the wild heart of North Komodo, home to some of the most exhilarating dive sites in the region. Here, the ocean surges with life—reef sharks glide through the current, schools of fish swirl above intricate coral formations, and dramatic underwater topography promises unforgettable moments.

On land, trek up Gili Lawa Darat for panoramic views—especially breathtaking at sunrise or sunset. The bays below invite quiet paddles, beach swims, and peaceful snorkeling sessions.

You'll spend two nights anchored near Gili Lawa, wrapped in the quiet energy of this northern wilderness.

Diver Highlights:

- **Crystal Rock** – Adrenaline-fueled pinnacle dive with reef sharks and trevallies.
- **Castle Rock** – High-current drama with jacks, fusiliers, and vibrant coral.
- **Shotgun** – A thrilling drift with soft coral gardens and surprise pelagic sightings.
- **Golden Passage** – Scenic drift through a fish-filled channel rich in color and life.

DAY 07 - 08

CENTRAL KOMODO

As dawn breaks, Jakare lifts anchor and sails south into the beating heart of Komodo National Park. After breakfast on deck, dive into the nutrient-rich waters of Karang Makassar or Mawan, where you might find yourself in the graceful company of manta rays and eagle rays gliding past for their morning spa.

Continue to Batu Bolong, a towering underwater pinnacle alive with motion—turtles, reef sharks, giant trevally, and a kaleidoscope of reef fish all swirl through this aquatic metropolis.

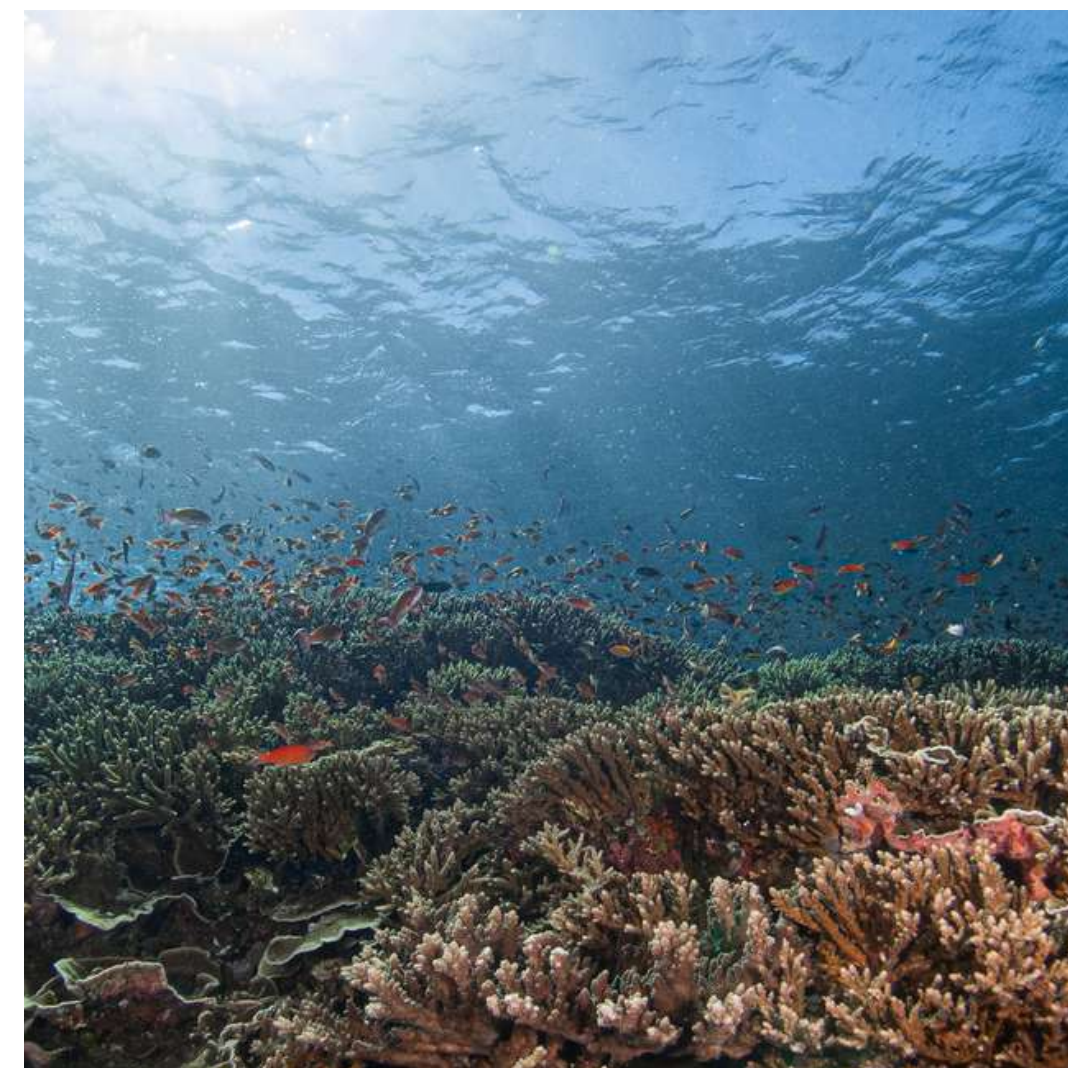
Not diving? No problem. Tatawa Besar offers gentle, accessible snorkelling and a chance to swim alongside dozens of turtles and rich coral life.

On the second day, discover hidden gems like Siaba Besar and Kecil, Pengah Kecil, and Police Corner. These dive sites are ideal for all levels—from beginners to experienced explorers.

Take breaks between dives with SUP sessions, beach landings on white sandbanks, or peaceful snorkels through shallow coral gardens. You'll overnight at Waenilu, tucked quietly at the northern tip of Pulau Rinca.

Diver Highlights:

- **Karang Makassar / Mawan** – Ideal for manta encounters.
- **Batu Bolong** – A legendary dive, packed with marine life.
- **Siaba Besar & Kecil** – Calm aquarium-like settings with healthy coral.
- **Tatawa Besar / Kecil** – Great for all skill levels, full of turtles.
- **Pengah Kecil & Police Corner** – Colorful reefs and big-fish action.





DAY 09

KOMODO DRAGONS AT PULAU RINCA & PULAU SABOLAN

Rise with the sun and take the dinghy ashore at Loh Buaya, where local rangers await to guide you on a jungle trek through Komodo dragon territory. Choose your trail—short and scenic or long and wild—and keep your eyes open for dragons, wild boars, deer, and tropical birds.

Back on board, enjoy a refreshing swim and a hearty breakfast before sailing east toward Pulau Sabolan.

If the sea gods allow, your last evening will feature a beach BBQ and golden-hour snorkeling in crystal-clear waters. White sands, warm breezes, and one final paddleboard session will bring your journey to a perfect close.

Diver Option:

- Diving may be offered depending on your flight schedule the next day.

DAY 10

FAREWELL IN LABUAN BAJO

At dawn, Jakare glides gently back into Labuan Bajo. There's time for one last swim at Pulau Sabolan, a final breakfast on deck, and some warm farewells with your crew and fellow adventurers.

Disembark with salt on your skin, stories in your heart, and memories that will follow you far beyond the horizon.
