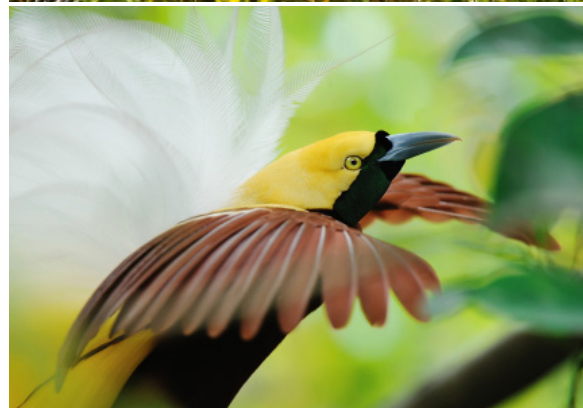
RAJA AMPAT

DESCRIBED BY SOME AS THE WORLD'S MOST BEAUTIFUL ISLANDS, RAJA AMPAT OFFERS STEEP JUNGLE CLAD LANDSCAPES, WHITE SAND BEACHES AND HIDDEN LAGOONS NOT TO MENTION SOME OF THE MOST BIODIVERSE MARINE LIFE ON THE PLANET.

Situated off the northwest tip of West Papua, Raja Ampat's six hundred islands are remote, undisturbed, and a true nature lover's paradise.

Bursting with color thanks to its incredible coral, the warm waters are home to reef sharks, manta rays and whale sharks and offer some of the best diving and snorkeling opportunities on the planet.

On land, many species of bird including the stunning Red Bird of Paradise can be seen, while local villages offer cultural excursions and some of the warmest hospitality you will ever encounter.



A SAMPLE 12 NIGHTS ITINERARY GREATER RAJA AMPAT

DAY 1: KABUI BAY (5 HOURS)

Early morning arrival in Sorong Airport where the crew will pick you up and bring you to Lamima. Once onboard, after a safety briefing, we will set sail for Waisai (Waigeo Island) where we will do the clearance. After the clearance is done, we will then move to a beautiful bay where we will enjoy water sports for the rest of the day.

DAY 2: KRI ISLAND (2 HOURS)

Early walk to witness the Bird of Paradise. They usually dance every day at sunrise before to leave their home tree for food. On our way back, we will visit a local village "Tapokreng" where we share a moment with the local, greet the student of the elementary school and may try some betel nuts. Back on Lamima, we will cruise to Kri Island, a long sandbank, good diving, and amazing kayaking through the hidden mangrove..

DAY 3: MIOSKAN ISLAND (2 HOURS)

A beautiful island with a pretty beach and some of the top dive sites in Raja Ampat (Blue Magic, Mioskon or Chicken reef). Mioskon means sitting island in the local Papuan dialect, its very famous on the island that you can see the Fruit Bat. The island has a very little but nice white beach. Good chances to see Wobbegong Shark and Pygmy Seahorses. Many schooling fish. In one of the close dive sites, we can sometimes see Manta Rays.

DAY 4: KAWA ISLAND (9 HOURS OVERNIGHT)

One of the closest islands to the Equator in Raja Ampat, Kawa Island offers spectacular white sand beaches and beautiful scenery including a lovely waterfall on the western side of the island. There are fantastic opportunities for diving and snorkeling here too where you will find impressive coral formations teeming with school of fishes. You may even be lucky enough to swim with Manta Rays.

DAY 5-6: WAYAG ISLANDS (2 HOURS)

Arrive in the Wayag Archipelago, the jewel of Raja Ampat, and enjoy a day amongst the region's most iconic scenery. It's well worth making the effort to climb one of the many island peaks for breathtaking views of the stunning landscapes. You will also be able to dive or snorkel, experiencing the incredibly rich marine life, or paddleboard along the shoreline of the dramatic limestone islands. In the evening we can enjoy a few cocktails and a barbecue on the beach.

DAY 7: WOFOH ISLAND (5 HOURS)

Wofoh Island is ideal for divers and non-divers alike. Multiple dive sites offer a mix of hard corals, barrel sponges and soft corals teeming with colorful fish. The calm surrounding waters are ideal for kayaking and paddle-boarding, while the islands' gorgeous white sand beaches are the perfect location for sundowners and barbeque dinner.

DAY 8: FAM ISLANDS (4 HOURS)

This morning sail to the beautiful Fam Islands to enjoy hidden bays and sheltered blue lagoons. Explore by kayak or dive to see some of the most beautiful coral gardens in the region. In the early evening, we will take a sunset hike where you can reach the highest point on one of the islands and admire the panoramic views.

DAY 9: TOMOLOL (12 HOURS OVERNIGHT)

Today we anchor in Tomolol Bay on Misool Island. This bay is home to hundreds of small karts islands which are each more appealing than the others. This is a paradise to explore with one of our tenders and you can literally get lost in this maze all for yourself, the sea is crystal clear, very sheltered and the scenery exceptional. We will visit a massive cave where you can either go with a canoe, paddleboard

or swim through, stalactites are enormous, light is minimum and peace is everywhere. This cave today is a sacred site for the local people. At night you will enjoy a memorable barbecue prepared by our crew.

DAY 10: WAYIL BATAN (4 HOURS)

Another magical place that you want to explore with a paddleboard to enter in the shallow bays of the island. You will find a lot of birdlife as well as close to the reef. Wake-boarding between the little mushroom islands is highly recommended.

DAY 11: FIABACET (2 HOURS)

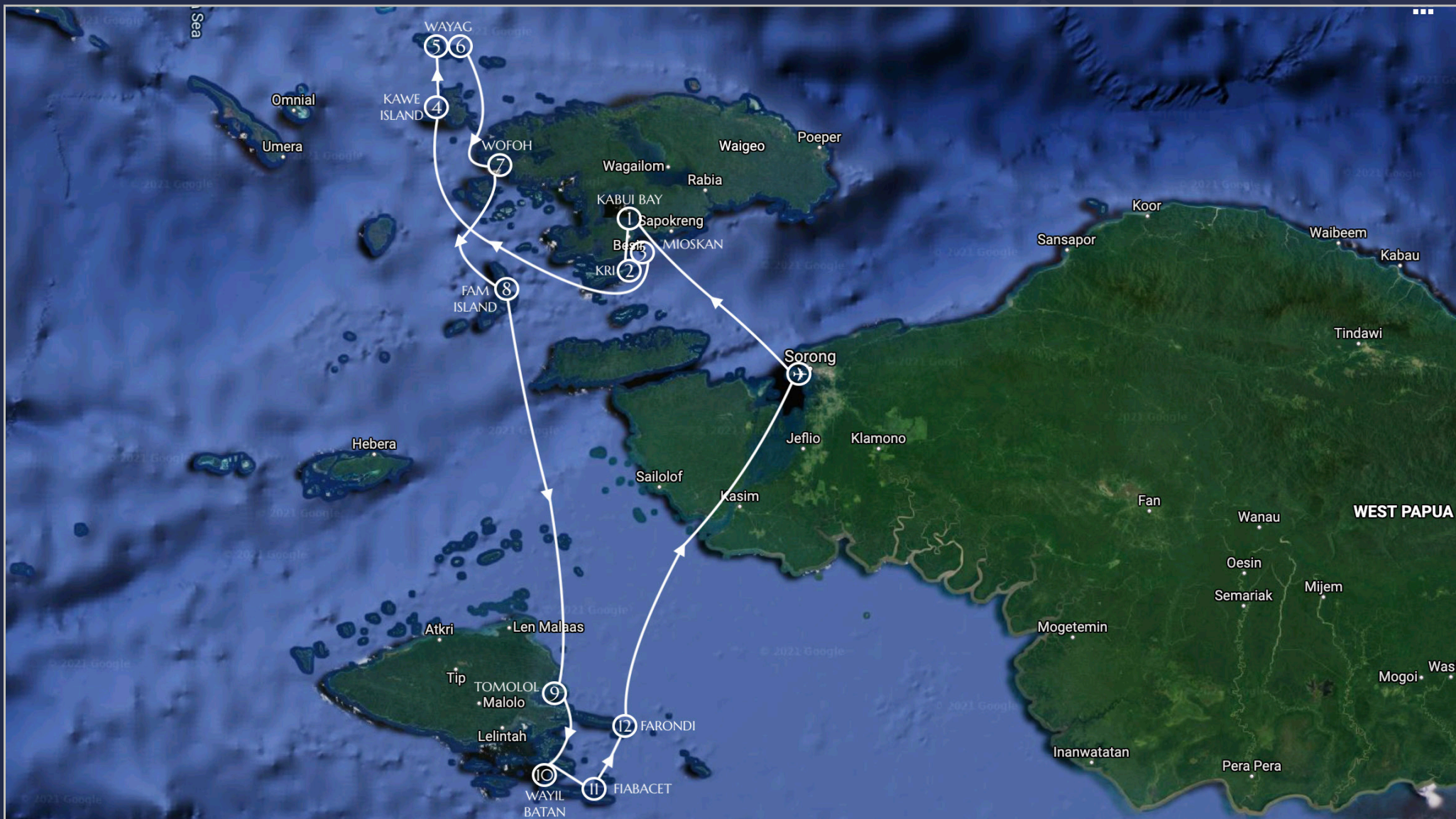
A great spot for divers due to its colorful soft corals all the way to the surface. Lots of schools of fish, Pigmy seahorse, and manta rays are often seen here. Locals call this area "The house reef".

DAY 12: FARONDI (3 HOURS)

This small group of islands is often the favorite place for the divers due to its very specific seascape: great marine life and amazingly diverse and colorful coral. Perfect rugged bays to explore in Kayak or paddleboard.

DAY 13: SORONG (11 HOURS OVERNIGHT)

Early morning cruise to Sorong where you will disembark after breakfast. A tender and private vehicle will transfer you to Sorong airport for your journey home or onward travel.
