Komodo National Park, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site, covers an expansive area of 1,733 square kilometers within Indonesia's Lesser Sunda Islands. Renowned for being the natural habitat of the Komodo the world's largest lizard-the park is a treasure trove of diverse wildlife and striking landscapes, ranging from arid savannas to lush tropical forests.

The park also boasts a rich marine ecosystem featuring over 1,000 species of fish and 260 types of coral.

It is a prime location for encountering manta rays and sea turtles, making it a premier destination for diving and snorkeling enthusiasts. Visitors can explore the park's three principal islands-Komodo, Rinca, and Padar-each offering spectacular vistas, secluded beaches, and unparalleled opportunities to observe unique wildlife.

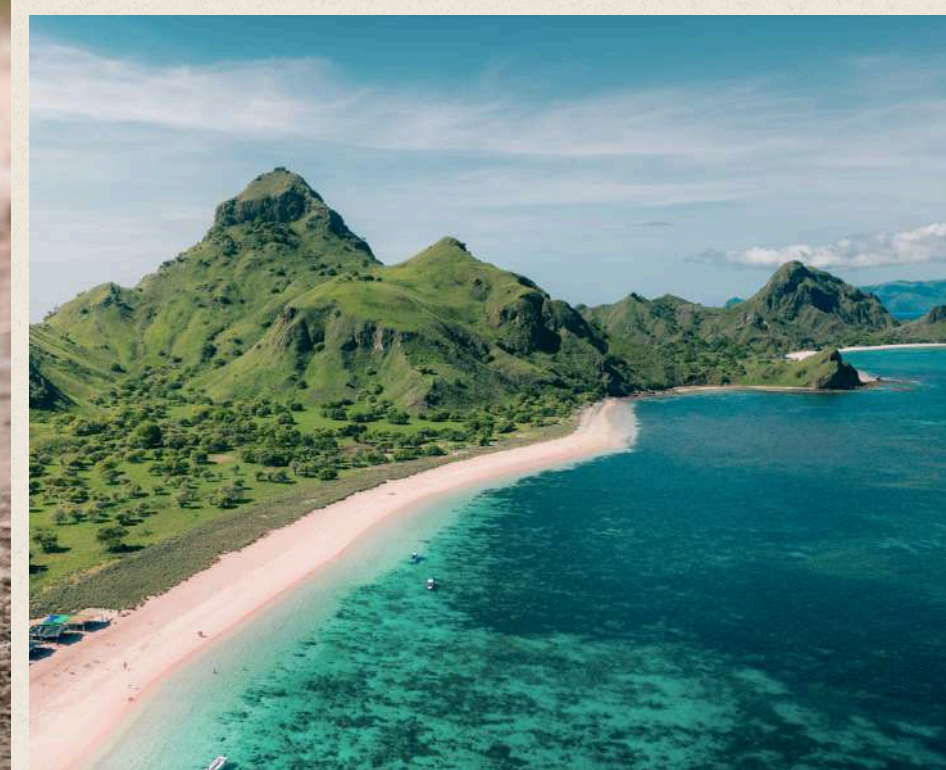
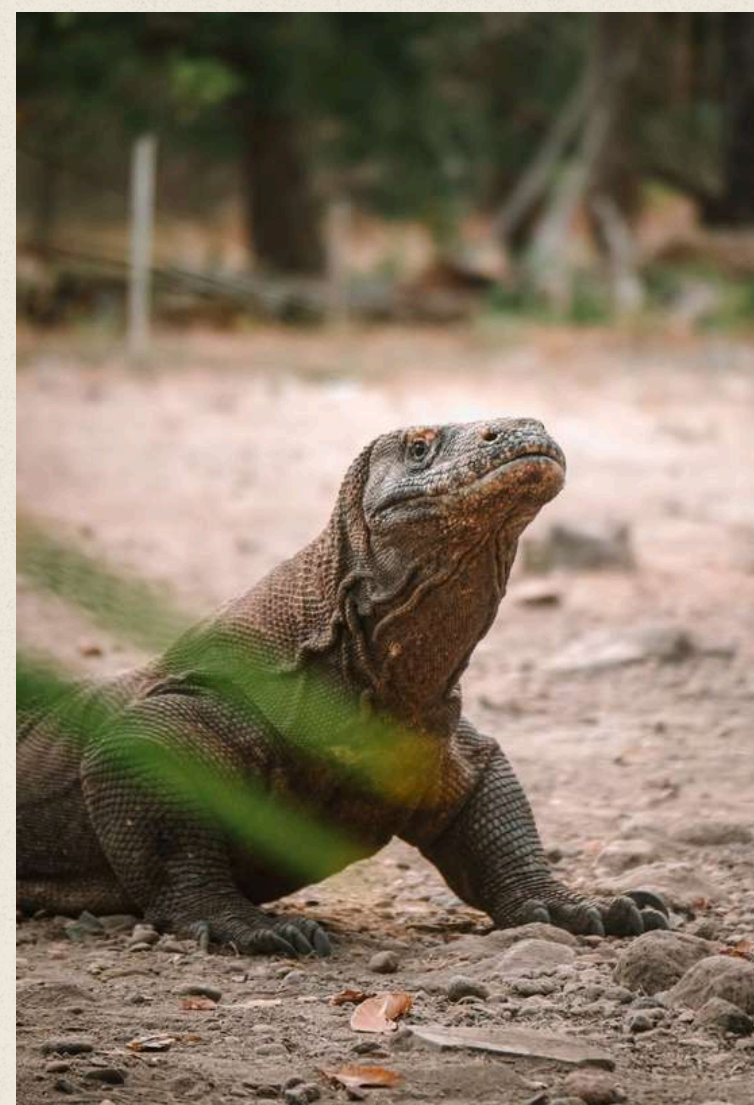
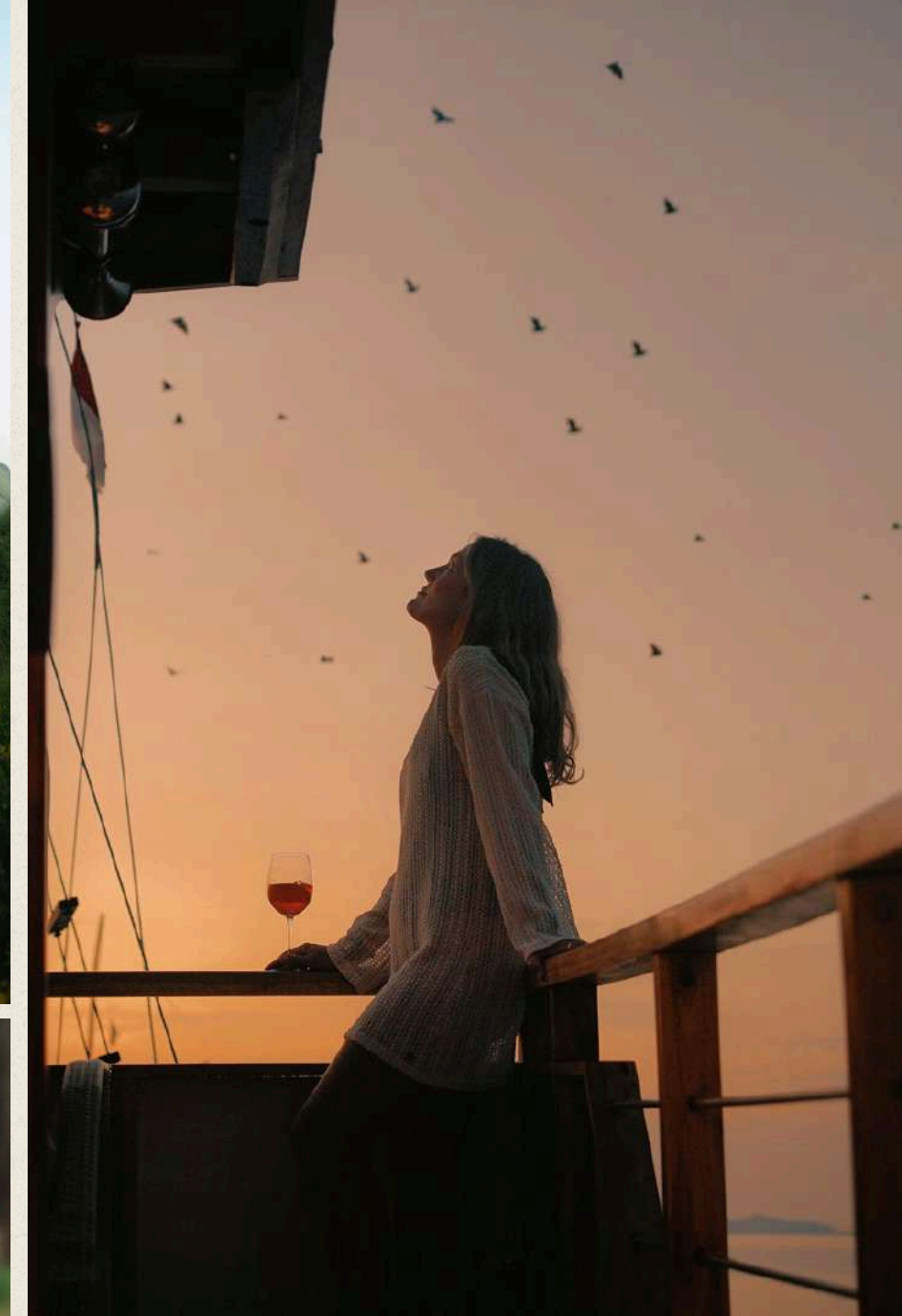


KOMODO NATIONAL PARK | 4 DAYS 3 NIGHT

01

Kelor | Manjerite | Pink Rock | Kalong

Your journey begins at Kelor Island with a short hike or a relaxing swim, followed by a delicious lunch onboard. Afterward, head to Manjerite for marine exploration, then proceed to Pink Rock for snorkeling and paddleboarding amidst vibrant coral reefs. As the day winds down, catch the breathtaking sunset at Kalong Island, where thousands of flying foxes take to the sky. End the day with dinner onboard while cruising towards Padar Island for an overnight anchorage.

Padar | Pink Beach Padar | Komodo | Pink Beach Komodo

Start with an early sunrise hike at Padar Island, followed by breakfast onboard. Then, head to Pink Beach on Padar for snorkeling and relaxation. Afterward, visit Komodo Island for a trek to see the famous dragons, and enjoy lunch on the boat. In the afternoon, unwind with snorkeling, relaxing, or paddleboarding at Pink Beach Komodo before dinner onboard and anchoring overnight.



Day 03

Manta Point | Taka Makassar | Siaba

Start with breakfast while cruising to Manta Point for an exciting snorkeling with majestic manta rays. Next, visit Taka Makassar, a beautiful tiny sandbar, for snorkeling or simply relaxing. Savor lunch as you cruise toward Siaba Island or Turtle Point for a chance to snorkel with sea turtles. Then head to Sebayur Besar to end the day with a BBQ dinner on the beach.

Day 04

Sebayur Kecil | Sebayur Besar

After breakfast, enjoy your final snorkeling sessions at Sebayur Kecil and Sebayur Besar, where you'll explore vibrant reefs and diverse marine life. Then, enjoy a delicious lunch onboard as we sail back to Labuan Bajo, wrapping up your unforgettable Komodo journey.
