The Realm of Dragons and Rich Marine Life

Komodo National Park, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site, covers an expansive area of 1,733 square kilometers within Indonesia's Lesser Sunda Islands. Renowned for being the natural habitat of the Komodo the world's largest lizard-the park is a treasure trove of diverse wildlife and striking landscapes, ranging from arid savannas to lush tropical forests.

The park also boasts a rich marine ecosystem featuring over 1,000 species of fish and 260 types of coral.

It is a prime location for encountering manta rays and sea turtles, making it a premier destination for diving and snorkeling enthusiasts. Visitors can explore the park's three principal islands-Komodo, Rinca, and Padar-each offering spectacular vistas, secluded beaches, and unparalleled opportunities to observe unique wildlife.

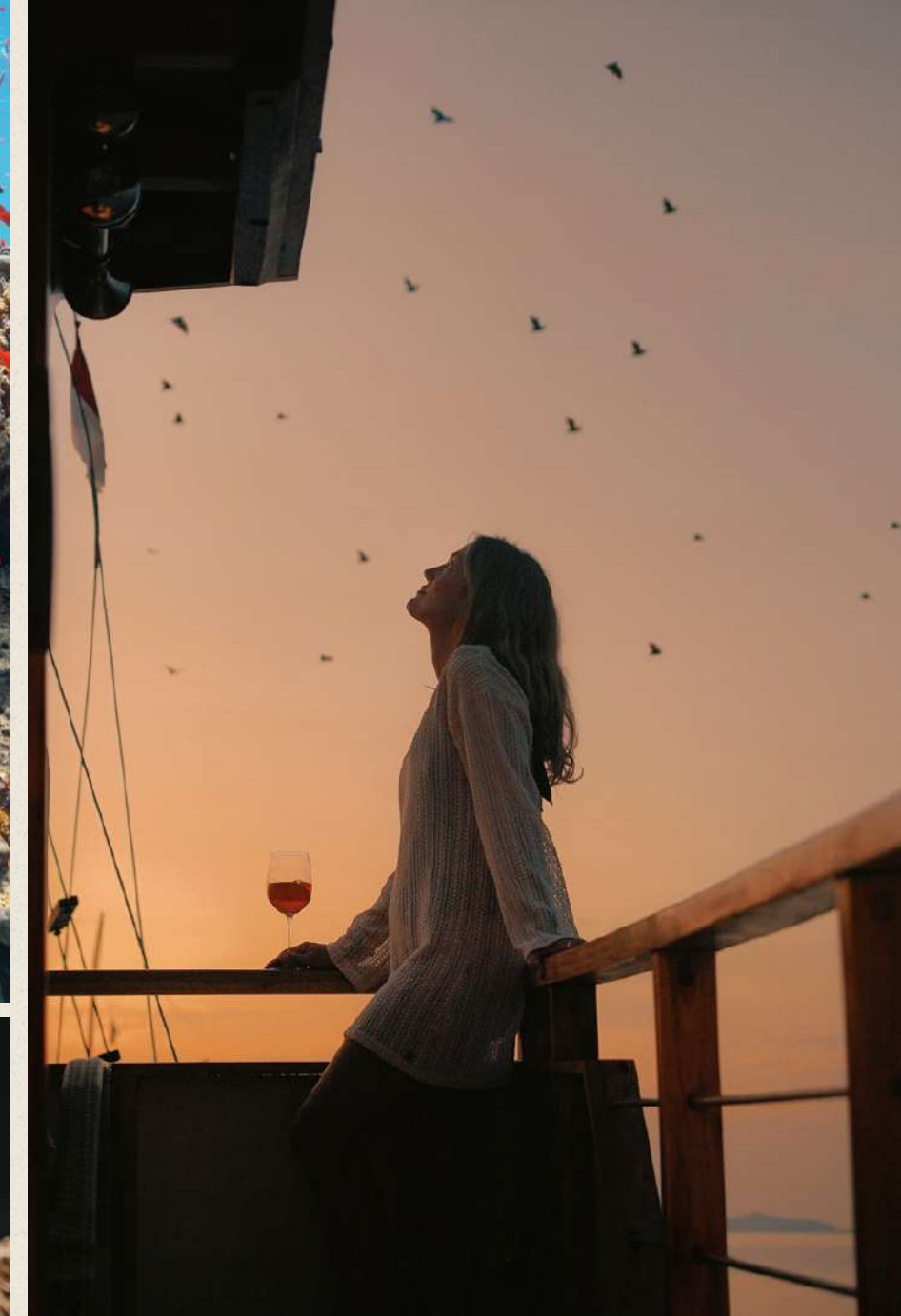

01

Kelor | Manjerite | Pink Rock | Kalong

Start at Kelor Island with a short hike for sweeping views, then cool off in its clear shallows. Snorkel Manjerite's colourful coral gardens, home to schools of reef fish. Continue to Pink Rock for bright corals and abundant marine life, before ending the day at Kalong Island to watch thousands of flying foxes take to the evening sky.

Rinca | Pengah Kecil | Siaba Besar

Visit Rinca Island for a guided walk to see Komodo dragons and other wildlife. Snorkel the reefs of Pengah Kecil, where vibrant corals attract large schools of fish. End the day in Siaba Besar's calm bay, an excellent spot for swimming alongside sea turtles.

Mawan | Gili Lawa Laut | Gili Lawa Darat

Snorkel Mawan's gentle coral slopes, and if you're lucky, see manta rays visiting a cleaning station — a special spot where small reef fish gather to remove parasites from the mantas' skin. Continue to Gili Lawa Laut for crystal-clear waters filled with vibrant marine life. In the late afternoon, hike Gili Lawa Darat for one of Komodo's most iconic sunset views.

Taka Makassar | Manta Point | Padar Island

Stroll along the bright white-sand spit of Taka Makassar, a beautiful sandbank surrounded by shallow turquoise water. Continue to Manta Point for the chance to snorkel alongside graceful manta rays as they glide through the currents. In the afternoon, sail to Padar Island and hike to its world-famous viewpoint, where three bays each show off a different coloured beach.

Pink Beach Padar | Komodo | Pink Beach Komodo

Start the morning at Padar's Pink Beach, where the rosy sand meets a reef full of colourful corals just offshore. Next, visit Komodo Island for another guided walk to spot the legendary Komodo dragons in their natural setting. Finish the day at Komodo Pink Beach, perfect for swimming in clear water or snorkelling among healthy coral gardens.

Tatawa Kecil | Tatawa Besar

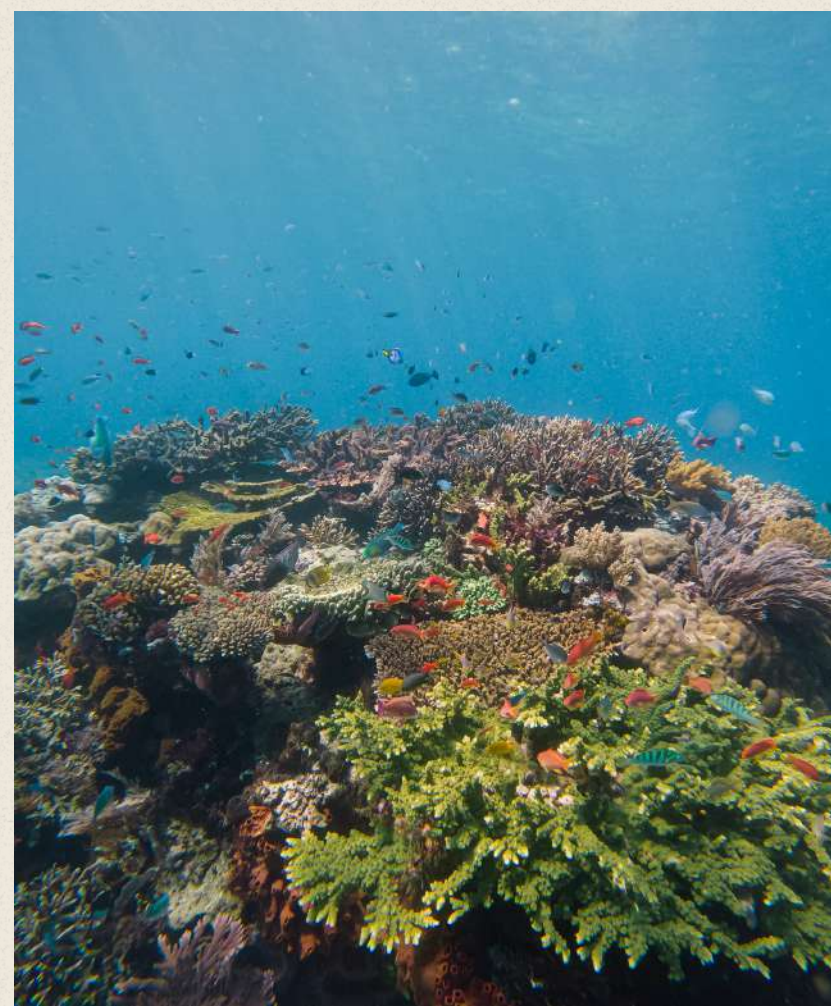
Enjoy a drift snorkel at Tatawa Kecil, where soft corals sway in the current and reef fish flash bright colours in the sunlight. Then move on to Tatawa Besar for a gentler snorkel along coral-covered slopes, with a good chance to see sea turtles grazing among the corals. After your snorkel, spend some time relaxing on the island's sandy beach before returning to the boat.

07

Sebayur Kecil | Sebayur Besar

Spend a slow and relaxing day between Sebayur Kecil and Sebayur Besar. Both islands offer inviting sandy beaches, clear blue water, and colourful reefs just a short swim from shore. Paddleboard in the calm bays, explore the reef with mask and snorkel, or simply float in the shallows and enjoy the peace of the islands. As the sun begins to set, gather on the beach for a final BBQ dinner under the stars, with the sound of the waves as your backdrop.

08

Rangko Cave | Papangga Island | Seraya Besar

Visit Rangko Cave, where a hidden seawater pool glows a brilliant blue when sunlight streams through the entrance. Afterwards, stop at Papangga Island for a beach swim and a chance to explore its coral fringe. Continue to Seraya Besar for more snorkelling, kayaking, or a lazy afternoon on its long white-sand beach, complete with a relaxed picnic by the water.

Bidadari Island | Sture Island

Snorkel in the shallow coral gardens of Bidadari Island, where schools of colourful tropical fish weave through the reef. End the trip at Sture Island, with one last swim or snorkel in Komodo's warm, clear waters before returning to port.
