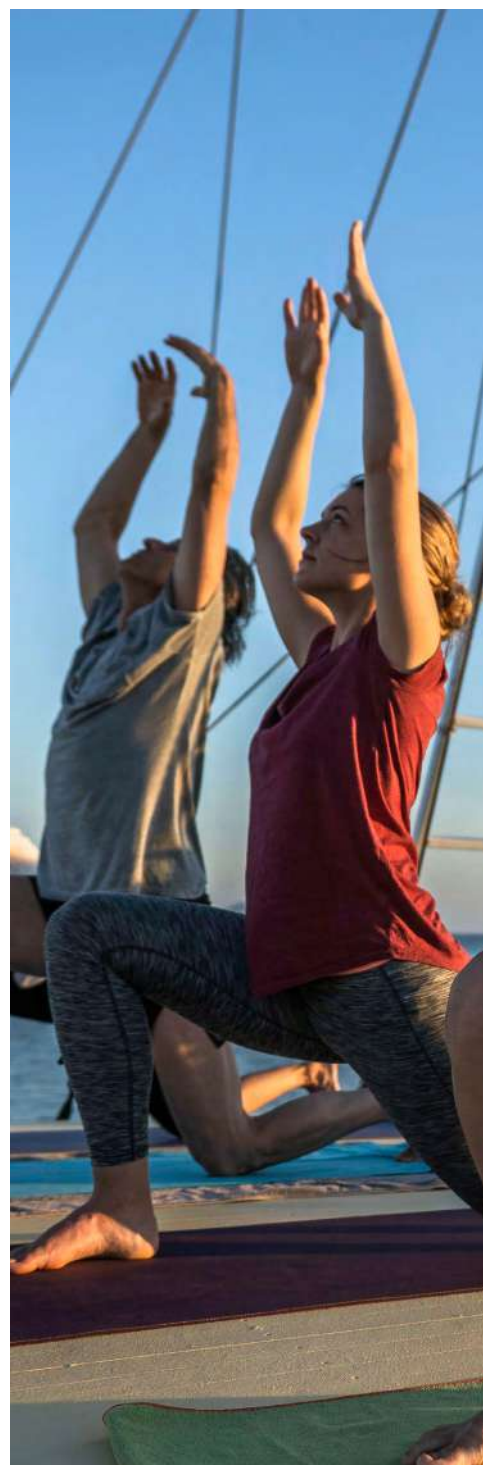
- Beach and shower towels

For The Divers

Please Bring:

- Health check-up / medical certificate confirming your ability to scuba dive. If possible
- Compulsory diving insurance for your own safety (such as DAN or Aquamed or other).
- Diving certifications.
- Diving logbook.
- Your own diving equipment if you wish.

Onboard our tanks are all equipped with International Connecting System (Yoke), hence, please bring your own International-to-DIN adapter if required.



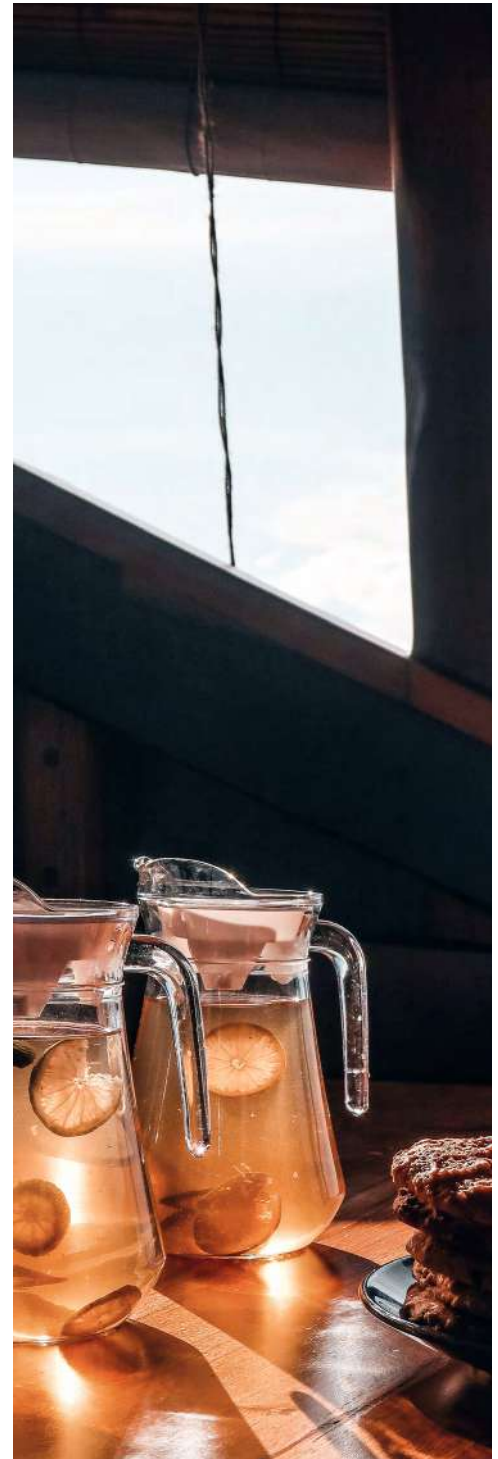


Additional Fees

Tipping on Board – A Meaningful Gesture On cruise boats around the world, it is customary to leave a tip for the crew at the end of the trip.

- In Indonesia, the local guideline is around **10% of the cruise price**. This is not to cover low wages, but to recognize the crew's hard work and dedication — often for 10-12 days straight — to make your journey truly special.
- Tips are **shared equally** among all crew members, including those working behind the scenes.
- In many cases, your tip supports not just one person, but **entire families and communities**. It's a simple and meaningful way to give back and show your gratitude and appreciation.

That said, tipping is **not mandatory**. These are just guidelines. What matters most is that it reflects your **personal level of satisfaction** with the service you received.





Additional Fees (cont)

Entrance fees for National Parks: These are usually paid in advance, but if not, please check with us for the latest applicable fees.

Diving certifications, equipment rental & Nitrox (if not already paid).

Souvenirs & onboard items: T-shirts, hats, jewelry, and other goodies are available for purchase.
Alcohol on board.

Other souvenirs you may wish to buy onshore.

*Note: We accept payments in **cash (IDR, EUR, USD)** and also **credit card payments** for your convenience.*

Mosquitoes

There are usually no mosquitoes on the boat because mosquitoes don't like salty waters. But you can still bring mosquitoes spray and long light sleeves for the jungle treks.





What to Bring

- If possible biodegradable sun cream, available in pharmacy and beauty shop.
- Lycra's t-shirt to be protected from the sun.
- Cap and sun glasses.
- The boat is equipped with Satellite Communication System and provide Wifi on board on all our destinations.
- 220V / 50Hz is available at all times and electrical sockets are European Style type C, E or F.
- There is a full first aid kit on board, but we recommend to bring you own medication, if you have a treatment or if you are seasick. And please let us know if you have any special medical conditions requiring special attention.
- Sea waters in most of our destinations are rich in planctons and small jelly fish that could cause micro stings and allergies: you may bring long sleeved rash guard and leggings to protect you.

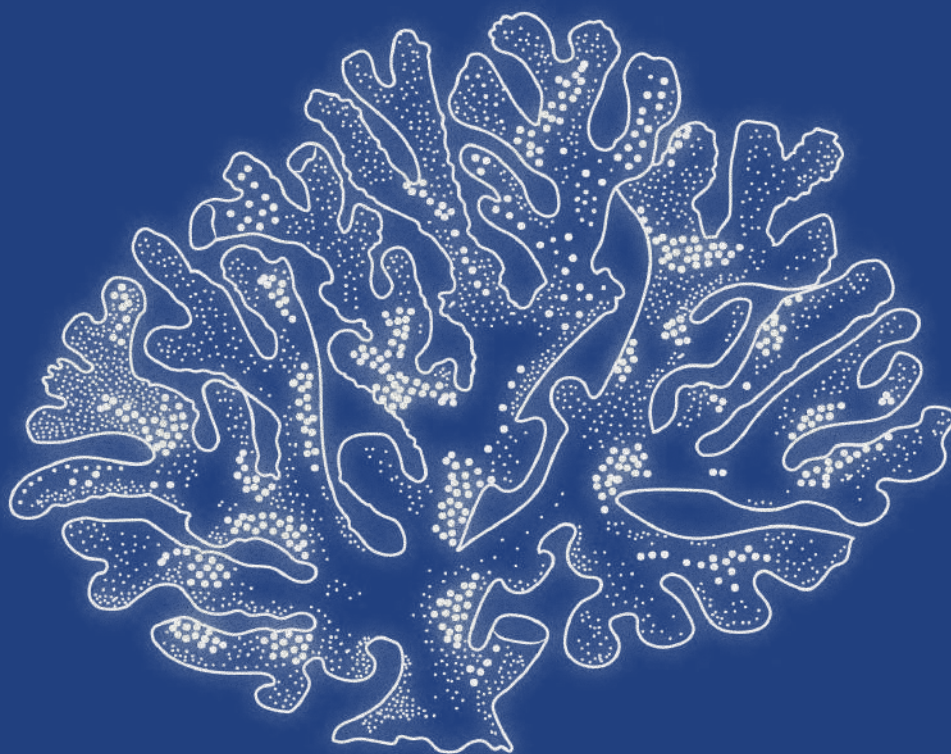

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03 WHAT ARE WE DOING FOR THE ENVIRONMENT



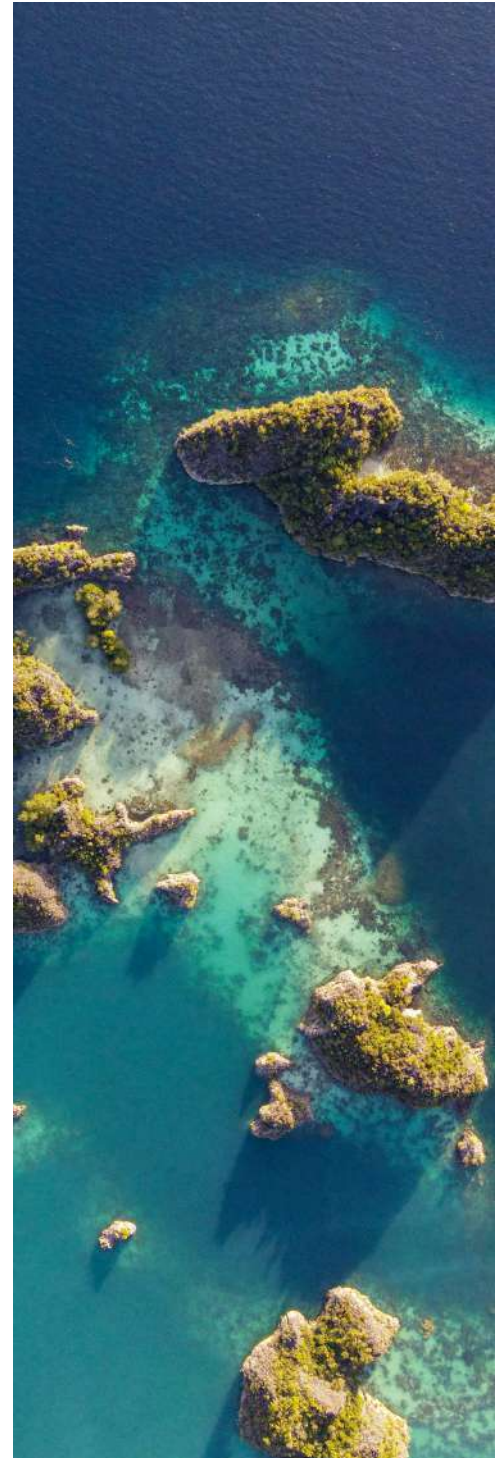
From the start, we prioritize environmental preservation through various initiatives:

We provide bamboo straws onboard to reduce plastic waste. Our upper deck features solar panels, harnessing solar energy to save power. This sustainable energy is stored in our batteries, ensuring a constant power supply on the boat.

We have implemented improved waste sorting practices, distinguishing between non-organic and aluminum cans. This minimizes post-trip trash and creates opportunities for recycling aluminum waste. We do support local initiative for waste transportation and treatment in various locations.

We proudly offer natural, hand-made soap on board. Crafted with gentle ingredients, it is suitable for the entire family's body and hair care needs. Each bathroom and common area is equipped with this eco-friendly alternative.

To minimize the use of toilet paper, every bathroom is equipped with showerheads, promoting waste reduction.





Respecting the environment encompasses several practices that we encourage on board the Jakaré:

Natural Products

Opting for biodegradable washing detergent and sunscreen helps prevent the release of harmful chemicals into the sea, preserving marine ecosystems.

Air Conditioning

We have designed the Jakaré to allow for natural ventilation in the common area, minimizing the need for air conditioning during the day. We kindly request your cooperation in maintaining this approach, as it significantly reduces energy consumption.

Plastic

We greatly appreciate your efforts in avoiding the use of plastic packaging while on board. By minimizing plastic waste, we contribute to the reduction of environmental pollution.

Fresh water

Help to minimize the consumption (and production) of fresh water on board by using it wisely.
