KOMODO NATIONAL PARK

JUST A SHORT FLIGHT FROM THE BEACHES OF BALI, KOMODO NATIONAL PARK IS A PLACE OF TRULY DIVERSE NATURAL BEAUTY AND INCREDIBLE WILDLIFE. OFFERING SIGNATURE PINK-SAND BEACHES AND SOME OF THE WORLD'S BEST DIVING, IT'S A DESTINATION THAT WON'T DISAPPOINT.

Teeming with sea life, Komodo National Park's plentiful coral reefs are considered to be some of the best in all of Indonesia. Dolphins and Manta Rays are a common sight and the area is also on a whale migration route.

The grassy sloped islands that make up the park offer visitors gentle trekking trails and beautiful beaches to relax on, as well as the opportunity to see the famous Komodo Dragons, the largest living lizards on the planet.



A SAMPLE 5 NIGHTS ITINERARY

DAY 1: GILI LAWA LAUT

On arrival at the airport, our crew will transfer you to Lamima. While the guests are relaxing and having lunch, we will set sail for Gili Lawa Laut. There, we will anchor in a secluded bay with stunning scenery close to some of the most exciting dive sites in Indonesia.

Here you will dive or snorkel with schools of fish including trevally, groupers, sweetlips, barracudas, and white tip reef sharks. These waters are teeming with incredible marine life. In the afternoon, we will take a hike to a spectacular view point from where we can see Lamima anchored in the bay.

In case, your arrival is in the afternoon, we will move to a nearby island called Papangga instead of Gili Lawa Laut. We will spend the rest of your first day here doing watersports and catch up with our itinerary during the following days.

DAY 2: TORO MABALANG (EAST SUMBAWA)

Outstanding white sand beach (slightly pink due to the red coral).

This sheltered bay will be the perfect place for watersport, beach combing, and night barbecue. The divers will enjoy the beautiful waters and colorful corals.

For the beginner diver the start from the beach will make it very easy.

On the evening you can go for a stroll above the beach to admire the anchorage with Lamima and the volcano in the background.

DAY 3: MT. SANGEANG ISLAND

We will take in the fantastic views of Mount Sangeang, an active volcano that last erupted in 2014. Thanks to the rich volcanic activity, Sangeang boasts stunning black sand beaches and vivid bright coral reefs which you can explore either by diving or snorkeling. There will also be an opportunity to visit a local village to observe traditional boat-building techniques

DAY 4: GILI BANTA

Today's calling point is the perfect spot for a relaxed day of walks on the long white sand beach or perhaps some watersports in a sheltered bay surrounded by beautiful scenery as jetskiing is allowed in this area. With its hard coral gardens, it's a great place for shallow and drift diving with the possibility of swimming with Manta Rays.

DAY 5: TORO MONCO

During our early cruise to North Komodo, we will stop on Teluk Boko where we will be able to witness Komodo Dragons on the beach. Then we will continue our journey and drop anchor in front of Toro Monco, a beautiful white sandy beach sheltered in a majestic bay in the Northwest of the Komodo National Park.

It is an excellent diving spot and perfect to do watersports.

DAY 6: BIDADARI

For your final morning onboard Lamima, enjoy your last watersports session before we transfer you back to the port by tender from where a private vehicle will take you to Labuan Bajo Airport for your onward journey.
