

BEYOND THE BASICS: LAMIMA GUEST FAQ

Cruising Area

1. What regions does Lamima sail to, and when is the best time to go?

Our journeys span across some of Indonesia's most iconic regions — including Komodo, Raja Ampat, the Spice Islands, Maumere, Alor, and Triton Bay. Each destination brings its own unique charm, but all share a sense of stillness, authenticity, and quiet wonder that makes exploring them by private yacht an experience like no other.

Lamima sails in two main regions: **Komodo** and **Raja Ampat**, following the best weather patterns throughout the year.

- From **May to October**, we are in the **Komodo region** (including Flores and Sumbawa).
- From **November to April**, we explore **Raja Ampat**, often including the **Spice Islands**, in October/November

By shifting between these regions, we **avoid the monsoon** and offer guests the best conditions year-round.

2. Which airports are the best when traveling to meet Lamima?

No matter where your journey starts, arriving to Lamima is seamless and stress-free. We anchor close to the nearest airport in each destination, ensuring smooth travel connections for our guests.

Once you land, our crew, Ali and Martinus, will greet you and arrange a private vehicle transfer to the harbor, followed by a comfortable RIB tender ride directly to the yacht. From airport arrival to stepping aboard Lamima, every detail is thoughtfully handled — so you can start relaxing the moment you arrive.

Flights & Arrival Details

For Sorong (Raja Ampat area)

- Airport: Sorong Airport, West Papua
- Transfer: Approx. 10 minutes to the harbor
- Flight routes:
 - Jakarta → Sorong (direct) Recommended
 - Bali → Sorong (direct twice a week or via Makassar)

For Labuan Bajo (Komodo/Flores/Sumbawa)

- Airport: Labuan Bajo
- Transfer: Approx. 10 minutes to the harbor
- Flight routes:
 - Bali → Labuan Bajo (direct)
 - Jakarta → Labuan Bajo (direct)

All airports along our routes are serviced by scheduled airlines and private jet. Whether you're arriving by scheduled or chartered flight, we'll coordinate everything to ensure a seamless transfer to the yacht

Life on Board.

3. What's a typical day like on board Lamima?

Life on Lamima follows a natural rhythm — guided by experience, shaped by your preferences, and carried by the gentle hands of our crew.

Each evening during dinner, our cruise director Ali meets with you to present the plan for the next day — highlighting the beautiful places you'll visit and the best ways to enjoy them. But nothing is fixed. If you feel like changing the plan in the morning, it's never a problem — our crew is flexible, and with so many options available, there's always something special to do.

Mornings often begin with sunrise yoga or fitness sessions on deck, guided by Koko or Listi. We provide everything you need — yoga mat, dumbbells, a spinning bike, boxing bag, skipping rope, TRX, pull-up bar. Afterwards, guests can take a refreshing ice bath on deck — a fun and energizing group ritual that always sparks laughter.

Then comes a beautifully prepared à la carte breakfast, with all the classic egg and coffee options, plus a buffet of tropical fruits, pastries, cereals, and a daily Indonesian dish like Nasi Goreng, Soto Ayam...

Late mornings are perfect for diving or snorkelling, often split between those heading to sea and others relaxing at our beach setup with beanbags, umbrellas, water toys, and chilled drinks. Activities include paddleboarding, kayaking, sailing, jet-skiing, e-foiling, or simply unwinding on the sand. Our onboard masseuses, Koko and Listi, also offer beauty treatments — complimentary and available all day.

As the morning fades, guests return for a delectable lunch on our alfresco deck, followed by a peaceful rest, massage, or more dives or water sports.

In the late afternoon, we often take a short sunset hike to a viewpoint, where our team — Ali, Martinus, Risky, or Bambang — serves drinks as you enjoy the scenery.

Evenings begin with cocktails at the indoor bar or alfresco on the main deck under the stars. Then it's time for dinner, often served outdoors, with fine cuisine and ocean breezes.

For those seeking calm, Koko also offers evening meditation sessions — a peaceful way to close the day beneath the stars.

4. What is the crew like on Lamima?

6. Can we bring our own staff e.g. a nanny?

Yes, you're welcome to bring your own staff — such as a nanny — and they'll be comfortably accommodated as part of your group in one of our seven guest cabins.

While our Indonesian crew are wonderful with children and happy to assist wherever possible, parents and guardians remain responsible for their children at all times while on board.

That said, many families find that our crew's warmth, attentiveness, and natural care create a relaxed and supportive environment for both children and parents throughout the journey.

7. Do we need to bring our own camera, or will our trip be photographed?

You're welcome to bring your own camera, but it's entirely optional. Lamima is fully equipped with a professional camera, underwater camera, and drone. Our first officer, Rizky, is always happy to capture the special moments of your journey, should you wish to have them and share them privately at the end of your charter. However, your privacy is always our priority. If you prefer not to be photographed or filmed, just let us know — and we'll fully respect your wishes.

Dining

8. Where are meals served?

Guests are always welcome to choose their preferred dining spot, but typically, breakfast is served in our elegant indoor dining room, while lunch and dinner are enjoyed alfresco on the main deck, surrounded by the sea and sky.

During lunch, a large sun awning provides shade and comfort, keeping the atmosphere cool and breezy. In the evening, the awning is removed so guests can dine under the stars, making dinner aboard Lamima a truly magical experience — especially when anchored in one of Indonesia's pristine, remote bays.

9. Can the chefs accommodate special dietary needs or preferences?

Absolutely. Whether you're plant-based, gluten-free, or simply prefer "no coriander, please," our chef and crew are attentive to every dietary preference. Before your charter begins, we'll ask you to complete a detailed preference form — this helps us tailor menus that suit your tastes and dietary needs, including any allergies or medical restrictions, which we handle with the utmost care.

Once on board, dining remains flexible and personal. Each morning, our chef will check in to see what you feel like enjoying for lunch and dinner — whether it's something light and refreshing or a special dish you're craving. 11. What alcohol is included during the charter? Can we request special wines or champagne?

Lamima offers a generous complimentary selection of alcoholic beverages as part of your charter experience, including:

- Unlimited crafted cocktails and mixers
- Unlimited local beers
- Seven bottles of selected wine per night (per group), curated from our rotating wine list

We maintain an onboard inventory of approximately 600 bottles, and while our selection changes regularly, we always offer good-quality wines, with an average value of around USD 40 per bottle.

In addition, we hold a collection of fine liquors and premium spirits, and a curated list of champagnes and rare wines available for onboard purchase — ideal for special occasions or connoisseurs.

If you have specific preferences, we're happy to assist. We can connect you with our trusted wine supplier and provide their catalogue, so you can pre-order your favorite bottles ahead of your trip.

12. Are all activities included, and is there a limit?

Yes — every onboard activity is fully included in your Lamima experience, with no extra charges and no limits on enjoyment. Whether you're diving vibrant reefs, jet-skiing or e-foiling secluded bays, paddleboarding at sunrise, joining guided excursions, or unwinding with yoga and massages, it's all part of your all-inclusive luxury yacht charter.

The only optional cost is for guests who wish to complete their PADI diving certification during the trip, which is available for USD 800 with our professional, certified dive instructors.

13. I never dived before, but I would like to try. Is it possible?

Yes, we are a PADI registered centre and you're more than welcome to give it a try! We offer Discovery Dives for guests who aren't certified — a relaxed, one-on-one experience with Ali or Martinus, our certified dive instructors. It's the perfect way to explore the underwater world safely and at your own pace.

If you enjoy it and wish to go further, you can complete your PADI Open Water Certification right on board. We'll need a minimum of one week to complete the course, and the cost is USD 800, including all instruction and materials.

Whether it's your first time diving or you're ready to get certified, Lamima is the perfect place to start your underwater adventure.

14. I'm a certified diver but haven't dived in a long time — can I still join the dives on Lamima?

Upon arrival, we'll begin with a relaxed check dive to gently assess your comfort and skill level in the water. Based on this, our dive instructor, Ali, will recommend the best dive sites for you — ensuring each experience matches your abilities and allows you to fully enjoy the underwater beauty of Indonesia with confidence and ease.

15. I am already certified and want to upgrade my open water to advanced diver. Is this possible?

Yes, you can! We are a PADI registered centre. If you're already a certified diver and would like to upgrade to the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver certification, Lamima is the perfect place to do it.

You'll need to stay with us for a minimum of one week, and the course is available for an additional fee of USD 800. This includes personalized training with our certified dive instructor, all course materials, and unforgettable dives in some of Indonesia's most spectacular underwater locations.

16. Do I need dive insurance for scuba diving?

Yes, we kindly ask that all guests wishing to scuba dive have valid dive insurance in place before joining us. It's a simple way to ensure you're fully covered while exploring Indonesia's incredible underwater world.

If you don't have insurance, no problem — you're still welcome to dive, but we'll just ask you to sign a quick waiver confirming your understanding that Lamima isn't liable in the unlikely event of a diving-related issue.

At Lamima, your wellbeing is at the heart of everything we do. As the only luxury phinisi yacht in Southeast Asia built to full international class certification (RINA), Lamima meets the highest global standards for safety, stability, and environmental responsibility.

Built and maintained under the expert supervision of RINA — one of the world's most trusted maritime authorities — every element of Lamima's design has been carefully engineered and inspected, from her solid ironwood hull to advanced fire protection and emergency response systems.

18. Is there a doctor or medical support on board Lamima?

While there is no doctor on board Lamima, we carry a basic medical first aid kit, including an AED defibrillator.

We also maintain direct contact with trusted medical professionals onshore. In the rare event of a serious health concern, we are trained to coordinate with air ambulance services for rapid medical evacuation to the best hospital in Jakarta.

With Lamima, you can explore remote destinations with confidence — knowing every precaution has been taken to ensure your safety and peace of mind.

19. Is there Wi-Fi?

You will enjoy unlimited high-speed Wi-Fi throughout Lamima, powered by Starlink's maritime satellite internet. Whether you're sailing through the remote islands of Indonesia or anchored in a quiet bay, you'll have seamless access to the world — perfect for sharing your journey or staying in touch with home and work.

22. What should we pack for a Lamima charter?

- Personal care kits with toothbrush, toothpaste, razor, and hairdryer
- International power adapters for your devices

- Any specific medications or personal items you prefer
